and treatment system for the city of Randolph; authorizing the sale and issuance 1.3 of state bonds. 1.4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA: 1.5 Section 1. WASTEWATER COLLECTION AND TREATMENT; RANDOLPH. 1.6 Subdivision 1. Appropriation. \$4,900,000 is appropriated from the bond proceeds fund 1.7 to the Public Facilities Authority for a grant to the city of Randolph to acquire land, predesign, 1.8 design, construct, install, furnish, and equip a wastewater collection and treatment system, 1.9 including water stabilization ponds, in and within one-half mile of the city of Randolph. 1.10 Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, section 16A.86, this appropriation is available when 1.11 \$2,420,000 of nonstate funds, including \$500,000 from Dakota County, is committed to 1.12 the project. 1.13 Subd. 2. Bond sale. To provide the money appropriated in this section from the bond 1.14 proceeds fund, the commissioner of management and budget shall sell and issue bonds of 1.15 the state in an amount up to \$4,900,000 in the manner, upon the terms, and with the effect 1.16 prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 16A.631 to 16A.675, and by the Minnesota 1.17 Constitution, article XI, sections 4 to 7. 1.18 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment. 1.19
