### 1309.0305 SECTION R305, CEILING HEIGHT.

IRC Section R305.1 is amended to read as follows:
R305.1 Minimum height. Habitable rooms, hallways, corridors, bathrooms, toilet rooms, and basements shall have a ceiling height of not less than 7 feet ( 2134 mm ). The required height shall be measured from the finish floor to the lowest projection from the ceiling. Areas or rooms with ceiling heights less than 7 feet $(2134 \mathrm{~mm})$ are considered crawl spaces.

## Exceptions:

1. Beams and girders spaced not less than 4 feet ( 1219 mm ) on center may project not more than 6 inches ( 152 mm ) below the required ceiling height.
2. Not more than 50 percent of the required floor area of a room or space is permitted to have a sloped ceiling less than 7 feet $(2134 \mathrm{~mm})$ in height with no portion of the required floor area less than 5 feet ( 1524 mm ) in height.
