

**2105.0184 MILITARY TEMPORARY LICENSE.**

Subpart 1. **Application and issuance.** In compliance with Minnesota Statutes, section 197.4552, the board shall issue military temporary (MT) licenses for cosmetologists, estheticians, nail technicians, eyelash technicians, salon managers, instructors, and school managers valid for a 12-month license cycle. An applicant for an MT license must submit:

- A. a completed application for an MT license;
- B. credentials establishing the applicant's identity as:
  - (1) an active duty military member;
  - (2) the spouse of an active duty military member; or
  - (3) a veteran with an honorable or general discharge who left service in the two years preceding the application date;
- C. a copy of a current valid license without a history of discipline for a cosmetologist, esthetician, nail technician, eyelash technician, salon manager, school manager, or instructor from another state; and
- D. payment of the fees required by Minnesota Statutes, section 155A.25.

Subp. 2. **Ineligible for renewal.** MT licenses are not eligible for renewal. Individuals issued an MT license must apply for a full practitioner's license under this chapter. If the individual has not been issued a regular license before the MT license expires, the individual must cease practicing until a license is issued.
