4626.0410 3-501.19 TIME AS PUBLIC HEALTH CONTROL.*

- Subpart 1. **Requirements.** Time only, rather than time in conjunction with temperature, may be used as the public health control for a working supply of potentially hazardous food before cooking, or for ready-to-eat potentially hazardous food that is displayed or held for service for immediate consumption, if:
- A. the food is marked or otherwise identified with the time within which it shall be cooked, served, or discarded;
- B. when the food that is provided for service and consumption is removed from temperature control, the food:
 - (1) is served or discarded within four hours; and
 - (2) is not removed from time control and returned for use at a later time;
- C. food in unmarked containers or packages, or for which the time expires, is discarded; and
- D. written procedures are maintained in the food establishment and made available to the regulatory authority upon request, to ensure compliance with:
 - (1) items A to C; and
- (2) part 4626.0385 for food that is prepared, cooked, and refrigerated before time is used as a public health control.
- Subp. 2. **Notification.** The food establishment must submit written notification to the regulatory authority of its intention to use the procedures provided under this part prior to implementing the provisions of this part.
