

7415.0800 POLICE OFFICER, TRAFFIC SIGNAL CONTROL.

Subpart 1. **Traffic-controlled intersections.** At intersections where traffic is controlled by a police officer, a traffic signal, or both, the patrol member shall direct the crossing of the children in conformity with the direction of the signal or the police officer.

Subp. 2. **Intersections not regularly controlled.** At intersections where there is no regular traffic control, the traffic may be sufficiently heavy to require the special assignment of a police officer at times when children are going to and from school. When this is done, the patrol member should cooperate with police officers.
