

7455.1100 INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

Subpart 1. Coverage for bodily injury and property damage. A driver must possess a current certificate of insurance or endorsement that indicates that the driver, or the driver's employer, has in full force and effect insurance coverage for bodily injury and property damage resulting from the operation of the pilot/escort vehicle, an act or omission by the operator of the pilot/escort vehicle, or both. The insurance or endorsement must be no less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit or \$1,000,000 per occurrence of commercial liability coverage, as applicable, and must be maintained at all times during the term of the certification. The insurance certificate must indicate on the face of the document that the policy is for the operation of pilot/escort vehicles and for pilot/escort duties and responsibilities as required by this chapter.

Subp. 2. Liability coverage. Pilot/escort vehicles must have a minimum amount of \$1,000,000 liability insurance. This is not a cumulative amount.
