7891.0120 MORTALITY REVIEW COMMITTEE.

Subpart 1. **Committee.** The HISA safety director shall convene and chair a mortality review committee for the purpose of gathering data surrounding the death of each racehorse occurring during racing or training at a licensed racetrack. The committee shall consist of the following:

- A. the chief steward or a designee;
- B. the chief commission veterinarian or a designee;
- C. the on-track commission veterinarian;
- D. the trainer or assistant trainer of the deceased horse;
- E. the jockey, exercise rider, or driver of the deceased horse;
- F. the attending veterinarian;
- G. the racetrack's director of racing or a designee;
- H. the track superintendent;
- I. the horseperson's representative; and
- J. any other person the HISA safety director determines is necessary to adequately examine the death.
- Subp. 2. **Participation.** Participation at a mortality review committee meeting is mandatory unless a member is excused by the chief steward or designee.
- Subp. 3. **Treatment records.** Treatment records required of the trainer by part 7877.0170, subpart 2, item U, shall be available to the committee upon request of the chief steward or commission veterinarian.
