## 8710.6200 SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST.

- Subpart 1. **Scope of practice.** A licensed school psychologist is authorized to provide direct and indirect psychological services to prekindergarten through grade 12 students who are at risk of social and academic failure.
- Subp. 2. Requirements for first professional license. A candidate for licensure as a school psychologist shall provide evidence of having completed a preparation program in school psychology accredited by the National Association of School Psychologists.
  - Subp. 3. [Repealed, 25 SR 805]
- Subp. 4. **Professional license.** A professional license shall be renewed according to the rules of the Board of Teaching governing professional licensure.
- Subp. 5. **Effective date.** Requirements in this part for licensure as a school psychologist are effective on September 1, 2001, and thereafter.
