8710.6200 SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST.

Subpart 1. **Scope of practice.** A licensed school psychologist is authorized to provide direct and indirect psychological services to prekindergarten through grade 12 students who are at risk of social and academic failure.

Subp. 2. **Requirements for first professional license.** A candidate for licensure as a school psychologist shall provide evidence of having completed a preparation program in school psychology accredited by the National Association of School Psychologists.

Subp. 3. [Repealed, 25 SR 805]

Subp. 4. **Professional license.** A professional license shall be renewed according to the rules of the Professional Educator Licensing and Standards Board governing professional licensure.

Subp. 5. Effective date. Requirements in this part for licensure as a school psychologist are effective on September 1, 2001, and thereafter.
