9220.0350 PUBLIC COMMENTS.

Subpart 1. **Written comments.** During the public comment period established in the public notice, any interested person may submit written comments on the action before the agency. To be considered by the agency in taking the action, comments must be in writing and must include the following:

- A. a statement of the person's interest in the action;
- B. a statement of the action the person wishes the agency to take; and
- C. the reasons why the person wants the agency to take the action.
- Subp. 2. **Public information meeting or contested case hearing request.** During the public comment period and at the agency meeting where the action is proposed to be taken, a person may request a public informational meeting or contested case hearing.
- Subp. 3. **Extension of comment period.** The public comment period may be extended if the commissioner finds an extension of time is necessary to facilitate additional public comment. Notice of the extension of the comment period must be given in the same manner as the original notice.
