9800.1500 PETITION FOR INTERVENTION.

Subpart 1. **Scope.** Persons shall be permitted to intervene according to Minnesota Statutes, section 176.361, subdivision 1.

- Subp. 2. **Notice to potential intervenors.** Any person who may have an interest in a case must be placed on written notice of the right to petition to intervene as prescribed by part 1415.1100. A petition to intervene must be filed by the potential intervenor within 30 days of receiving notice.
- Subp. 3. **Contents of petition.** The contents and format of the petition to intervene must conform to part 1415.1200. Responses to the petition must be filed in accordance with part 9800.1400, subpart 3.
