1 Public Utilities Commission 2 Adopted Rule Governing Rule Variances 3 Rule as Adopted 4 4 MCAR S 3.0600 Variances. 5 The Public Utilities Commission upon written application or 6 upon its own motion may shall grant a variance to any of its 7 rules in an instance where it appears to the satisfaction of the 8 9 commission that: 1- A. Enforcement of the rule would impose an excessive 10 burden upon the applicant or others affected by the rule; 11 2- B. Granting of the variance would not adversely affect 12 the public interest; and 13 3- C. Granting of the variance would not conflict with 14 standards imposed by law. 15 The commission shall, within 30 days after receipt of an 16 application, notify the applicant in writing by written order of 17 the granting or denial of the variance and the reasons 18 therefor. A variance may be conditioned upon alternative 19 20 practices proposed by the applicant or imposed by the commission. Variances may be of limited duration, and may be revoked if a 21 material change occurs in the circumstances which justified the 22 23 variance, or if the applicant fails to comply with the specified 24 alternative practices.
