3 Adopted Rule Amending the Time and Fee Requirements for Certain  
4 Licenses and Authorizing a Duplicate License Fee

6 Rule as Adopted

7 4 MCAR S 11.032 Licenses; expiration; fees.

8 A. Expiration. Except as otherwise provided in this rule,  
9 all licenses issued or renewed under this rule expire two years  
10 from the date of issuance or renewal. Class "A" Master and  
11 Class "B" Master licenses issued or renewed before March 1,  
12 1982, expire one year from the date of issuance or renewal.  
13 Class "A" Master and Class "B" Master licenses issued or renewed  
14 on or after March 1, 1982, expire March 1 of the next  
15 even-numbered year after issuance or renewal. Electrical  
16 contractor licenses issued or renewed after August 31, 1981, but  
17 before September 1, 1982, expire September 1, 1982. Electrical  
18 contractor licenses issued or renewed after August 31, 1982,  
19 expire March 1 of the next even-numbered year after issuance or  
20 renewal.

21 B. Examination, issuance, and renewal fees. The following  
22 fees shall be payable for examination, issuance, and renewal:

23 1. For examination for each class of

1 electrician's license: \$25.00

2 2. For issuance of original license  
3 and renewal:

4 a. Class "A" Master \$35.00 a year

5 b. Class "B" Master \$20.00 a year

6 c. Class "A" Journeyman,  
7 Class "B" Journeyman, Class  
8 A or B Installer or Special  
9 Electrician \$10.00 a year

10 d. Electrical Contractor \$75.00 a year

11 3. If a Class "A" Master or Class "B" Master license is  
12 issued or renewed in accordance with A. for less than two years,  
13 the fee for the license shall be prorated on a monthly basis for  
14 each month or part of a month that the license is issued or  
15 renewed. The electrical contractor's license fee shall be  
16 prorated on a quarterly basis for each quarter or part of a  
17 quarter that the license is issued or renewed in accordance with  
18 A.

19 4. A license fee may not be refunded after a license is  
20 issued or renewed. However, if the fee paid for a license was  
21 not prorated in accordance with the requirements of B.3., the  
22 amount of the overpayment shall be refunded.

23 C. Reissuance fee. Any electrical contractor who seeks  
24 reissuance of his or her license after it has been revoked or  
25 suspended pursuant to rule Elec 26 of the Board of Electricity  
26 shall submit a reissuance fee of \$100 before the license is  
27 reinstated.

28 D. Duplicate license fee. The fee for the issuance of each  
29 duplicate license is \$3.

30 Repealer. Rule 4 MCAR S 11.032 as adopted at 6 State Register
