7 Rules as Adopted

8 11 MCAR S 1.0046 Purpose and statutory authority. The purpose
9 of 11 MCAR SS 1.0046-1.0048 is to establish minimum standards
10 for design and construction of protective headgear to be worn by
11 operators and passengers of motorcycles as required by Minn.
12 Stat. S 169.974, subds. 2, clause (d) and 4.

13 11 MCAR S 1.0047 Minimum standards for design and construction.
14 Protective headgear required to be worn by operators or
15 passengers of motorcycles shall be designed and constructed so
16 as to equal or exceed the specifications contained in Standard
17 No. 218 of the Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards as
18 published in Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, section
19 571.218 (1980). Protective headgear meeting this standard is
20 deemed approved by the Commissioner of Public Safety.

21 11 MCAR S 1.0048 Markings and identification.

22 A. Markings required. The manufacturer shall mark helmets
23 with the standard to which the helmet has been tested; the trade
24 mark or manufacturer's name or initials; and the model
25 designation.

26 B. Marking methods. The manufacturer shall mark the helmet
27 shell or a permanently attached part of the helmet by permanent
28 molding, stamping, branding, engraving, or etching.

30 Repealer. Rules of the Department of Public Safety, Safety
31 Administration Division, SafAd 49 and 50 are repealed.
