- 11 MCAR S 1.6101 Purpose and scope.
- Purpose. The purpose of 11 MCAR SS 1.6101-1.6106 is to 9
- provide general standards for the administration of the laws 10
- requiring that full names appear on driver licenses and motor 11
- vehicle records and to provide standards for subsequent name
- changes on these documents.
- B. Scope. The scope of 11 MCAR SS 1.6101-1.6106 is intended 14
- 15 to be confined within the framework and to be consistent with
- the provisions of Minn. Stat. chs. 168, 168A and 171. 16
- 11 MCAR S 1.6102 Definitions.
- A. Purposes. For the purposes of 11 MCAR SS 1.6101-1.6106, 18
- 19 the following terms have the meaning given them.
- 20 B. Driver's license and motor vehicle registration records.
- 21 Driver's license and motor vehicle registration records include:
- all applications for drivers' licenses, instruction 22
- permits and Minnesota identification cards; 23
- 2. all applications for motor vehicle certificates of 24
- title; and 25
- 3. all applications for motor vehicle registration plates. 26
- 27 C. Full name. Full name means the first name, middle name
- and surname. 28
- 29 D. First name. First name means the name given at birth
- that appears first in a person's full name. 30
- 31 Middle name. Middle name means the name given at birth
- between a person's first name and surname. 32
- 33 F. Surname. Surname means the last name borne in common by
- members of a family. 34
- 35 11 MCAR S 1.6103 Name, name combination, length.

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- A. Full name required. The full name is required on driver
- 2 licenses and motor vehicle records. It is comprised of the
- 3 first name, one or more middle names and one or more surnames.
- B. Length of full name. The full name may not exceed 28
- 5 characters and spaces. If the full name exceeds 28 characters
- 6 and spaces, it will be abbreviated by the Department of Public
- 7 Safety in a manner that will permit proper record storage and
- 8 printing on the record.
- 9 C. Name combinations. If a person has more than one middle
- 10 name or more than one surname, they may be used in combination
- 11 separated by a hyphen. If only one name in a combination is to
- 12 be used on the document, the name used must be the first name of
- 13 the combination name.
- 14 11 MCAR S 1.6104 Documentation of proof of name and identity.
- 15 A. Generally. At the time of application for a driver's
- 16 license or motor vehicle registration record, the applicant
- 17 shall present a Minnesota driver's license or Minnesota
- 18 identification card if either one of these has been issued to
- 19 the applicant. If the applicant possesses a driver's license,
- 20 chauffeur's license or instruction permit from another
- 21 jurisdiction it must be surrendered.
- 22 B. Other documentation. If the applicant cannot supply the
- 23 documentation specified in A., one of the following will be
- 24 accepted as proof of name and identity:
- 25 1. an original or certified copy of the birth certificate
- 26 of the applicant;
- 27 2. an identification card issued to the applicant by the
- 28 United States Armed Services;
- 29 3. an alien identification card form 194 or a passport
- 30 issued to the applicant if it meets the full name requirement
- 31 specified in 11 MCAR S 1.6103;
- 32 4. a certificate of motor vehicle title or registration
- 33 issued to the applicant by another jurisdiction if it meets the
- 34 full name requirement specified in 11 MCAR S 1.6103;
- 35 5. a certified school record of the applicant;
- 36 6. a baptismal record of the applicant; or

- 7. confirmation of the name and identity of an applicant
- 2 under 19 years of age by a parent, spouse or guardian who must
- 3 accompany the applicant and furnish proof of his or her name and
- 4 identity as provided in 1.-6. or in A.
- 5 11 MCAR S 1.6105 Documentation for change of name on driver's
- 6 license or motor vehicle registration and title application
- 7 records.
- 8 A. Generally. When a change of name is required by law or
- 9 requested by an applicant, the documentation in B. and C. is
- 10 required.
- 11 B. Specific Documentation. If the applicant is required by
- 12 law or desires to change his or her surname, add an additional
- 13 middle name or surname or change any name, the applicant shall
- 14 supply the most appropriate document from the following:
- 15 1. applicant's certificate of marriage or a certified
- 16 copy;
- 2. applicant's marriage license or certified copy;
- 3. a certified copy of a court order;
- 19 4. a certified copy of a divorce decree or dissolution of
- 20 marriage granted the applicant that specifies the name changes
- 21 requested; or
- 5. a certified copy of naturalization papers issued to
- 23 the applicant.
- C. Surname in place of middle name. After December 31,
- 25 1982, an applicant may use the applicant's surname prior to
- 26 marriage on the driver's license in place of the middle name.
- 27 The following is acceptable as proof of that name:
- 28 1. an original or certified copy of the applicant's birth
- 29 certificate;
- 30 2. the baptismal record of the applicant; or
- 31 3. a driver's license or instruction permit of the
- 32 applicant showing the surname of the applicant prior to marriage.
- 33 11 MCAR S 1.6106 Variances.
- 34 A. Commissioner may grant. The commissioner of Public
- 35 Safety may grant variances from 11 MCAR 66 1-6101-1-6105 S

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1 1.6104.
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- 2 B. Application for variance. If a person questions or
- 3 disagrees with the provisions of 11 MEAR SS 1-6101-1-6105 as
- 4 applied to him or her is unable to comply with the provisions
- 5 and requirements of 11 MCAR S 1.6104, he or she may make written
- 6 application to the Commissioner of Public Safety or his designee
- 7 for a variance from one or more of the provisions of 11 MEAR SS
- 8 1-6101-1-6105.
- 9 C. Documentation and review. A person applying for a
- 10 variance must submit written documentation of the reasons why a
- 11 variance should be granted, including the reasons the required
- 12 documents are not available. The applicant must provide
- 13 additional information regarding his or her name and identity,
- 14 such as names of relatives, date and place of birth, place of
- 15 residence, social security number, military service information
- 16 and any arrest information, to aid the commissioner in verifying
- 17 the applicant's identity.
- 18 D. Review. The Commissioner of Public Safety or his
- 19 designee shall review the request for the variance. and In
- 20 making a decision to grant or deny the variance, the
- 21 commissioner or his designee shall consider the following:
- 22 1. the availability of the required documents;
- 23 2. the degree of hardship placed on the applicant;
- 3. the effect of granting the variance on the public;
- 25 4. the effect of granting the variance on the integrity
- are accessed of granding one variance on the integral
- 26 of the record system; and
- 5. the trustworthiness of the information supplied by the
- 28 applicant regarding his or her name and identity.
- 29 E. Conditions for granting. The commissioner shall grant
- 30 the variance if all of the following conditions are present:
- 1. the documents required by 11 MCAR S 1.6104 are either
- 32 not reasonably available or do not exist;
- 33 2. compliance with 11 MCAR S 1.6104 would cause an undue
- 34 hardship for the applicant;
- 35 3. granting the variance will have no adverse effect on
- 36 the public;

- 4. granting the variance will not jeopardize the
- 2 integrity of the record system; and
- 5. the applicant has established his name and identity by
- 4 trustworthy evidence and documentation.
- 5 F. Decision. The Commissioner of Public Safety or his
- 6 designee shall grant or deny the request for the variance within
- 7 30 days of receipt of the request. The person shall be notified
- 8 of the decision by mail within the 30-day period.
