8 6 MCAR S 2.3120 Motor fuel emergency measures. Upon declaration  
9 of an energy supply emergency based upon a petroleum shortage,  
10 the Governor shall select from the following measures to reduce  
11 a motor fuel shortage.

12 A. (Unchanged.)

13 B. Employer-based motor fuel conservation measure.

14 1. The purpose of this measure is to conserve motor fuel  
15 by requiring certain employers to reduce employee commuting and  
16 business-related motor fuel consumption in an energy supply  
17 emergency. The department shall inform affected employers  
18 before May 25, 1983 of the requirements for participating in the  
19 employer-based conservation measure. The governor may not  
20 implement this measure before May 25, 1983.

22 C. School conservation measure.

23 1. and 2. (Unchanged.)

24 3. The governor may not implement the school conservation  
25 measure before October 1, 1982. School boards shall submit to  
26 the department before April 1, 1984, or within 45 days after  
27 declaration of an energy supply emergency, whichever comes  
28 first, an emergency motor fuel conservation plan as defined in  
29 paragraphs 6. or 7.
