7 3 MCAR S 2.062 Official identification tags and brands.

3 MCAR

A. Definition. For the purposes of this rule, "official 8 9 identification tag" means a metal identification eartag conforming to the nine-character alpha-numeric National Uniform 10 Eartagging System, contained in chapter 1, part I, paragraph M, 11 12 of the Brucellosis Eradication Uniform Methods and Rules, May 1, 1982 edition, issued by the United States Department of 13 14 Agriculture. It provides unique identification for each individual animal. 15

B. Sale and application. Official identification tags may 16 17 be sold only to veterinarians accredited under Code of Federal Regulations, title 9, section 160.1(d.), and may be applied only 18 by or under the direct supervision of an accredited 19 veterinarian. This requirement does not apply to official 20 identification tags issued to artificial insemination 21 22 technicians, identified as 41XAA through 41XZZ, or issued to the 23 Dairy Herd Improvement Association, identified as 41WAA through 41WZZ. 24

25 C. Other tags prohibited. Every person applying eartags to 26 cattle for purposes of compliance with rules of the Board of 27 Animal Health shall use official identification tags.

Animals with existing tags. When an animal is already 28 D. 29 identified by an official identification tag, that tag number 30 must be recorded for official records and another official identification tag may not be applied, except when the owner of 31 32 an animal already identified by an official identification tag wants the animal identified by an official vaccination 33 identification tag at the time of the animal's vaccination 34 35 against brucellosis.

36 E. Removal prohibited; exception. No person may remove

official identification tags, market cattle testing tags, or leg bands, or efface brands approved and registered by the Board of Animal Health under Minn. Stat. S 35.822, except that market cattle testing tags may be removed by a veterinarian securing a blood sample for a brucellosis test.
