7 4 MCAR S 13.024 Certification of schools.

8 A. Application. Upon filing a proper application, a school
 9 desiring certification shall be reviewed by the board. No
 10 certification will be issued unless the school files with the
 11 board satisfactory proof that the school will offer courses
 12 meeting the prescribed learning objectives, has reasonable
 13 training equipment and facilities, and has qualified
 14 instructors. Further, the coordinator shall file with the board
 15 a semiannual affirmative action plan and such other relevant
 16 information as the board may require. The affirmative action
 17 plan must describe objectives for the recruitment and retention
 18 of minority students and women in the law enforcement program.
 19 "Minority student" means a person of Black, Hispanic, Asian,
 20 American Indian, or native Alaskan heritage. Relevant
 21 information may include lesson plans and course outlines.

25 C. Retaking examinations. An applicant who fails an
 26 examination will be allowed to retake that examination two
 27 times, upon furnishing to the board a renewed written
 28 application and appropriate fee.

29 D. Remedial examination procedures. A third or subsequent
 30 retake of the examination will require the applicant to submit a
 31 remedial training plan to the executive director for board
 32 approval. This plan must be directed at deficiencies indicated
 33 in previous examinations and must include, at a minimum, the
 34 following:

- 35 1. training activities to be completed;

1 2. evaluation process to be used in verifying
2 satisfactory completion of the listed activities; and

3 3. date of completion of all activities.

4 An additional written application and appropriate fee will
5 be required for each administration of the examination.
