- requirements. 9
- A. Authority and purpose. This rule is adopted by the 10
- 11 commissioner pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 17.725 to
- prescribe conditions for the labels and procedures for labeling 12
- 13 soil and plant amendments.
- 14 B. Definitions. For the purposes of this rule, the terms
- "brand," "commercial fertilizer," "commissioner," "fertilizer 15
- material," "guaranteed analysis," "guarantor," "label," 16
- "labeling," "plant amendment," "plant food," "sewage sludge," 17
- and "soil amendment" have the meanings given them in Minnesota 18
- Statutes, section 17.713. 19
- 20 C. Label requirements.
- 1. Any soil or plant amendment, except for sewage sludge, 21
- which is offered for sale, sold, or distributed in this state, 22
- in bags or other containers, must have placed on or affixed to 23
- 24 the container the following information:
- 25 a. net weight;
- b. brand name; 26
- 27 c. guaranteed analysis;
- 28 name and address of guarantor;
- 29 e. directions for the soil or plant amendment's use;
- the soil or plant amendment's purpose or proposed 30 f.
- 31 use;
- g. the words "NOT A PLANT FOOD PRODUCT"; and 32
- 33 a statement listing the common or usual English
- name of all ingredients used in manufacturing or blending the 34
- 35 soil or plant amendment:
- The label requirements in C.l.g. do not apply to soil 36

- l or plant amendments or sewage sludge offered for sale that
- 2 contain fertilizer materials.
- 3 a. If the soil or plant amendment or sewage sludge
- 4 contains fertilizer materials that meet the plant food content
- 5 requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 17.721, the
- 6 fertilizer materials must be guaranteed and labeled in
- 7 accordance with Minnesota Statutes, sections 17.711 to 17.729
- 8 and 3 MCAR S 1.0327.
- 9 b. If the soil or plant amendment or sewage sludge
- 10 contains fertilizer materials that do not meet the plant food
- ll content requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 17.721, the
- 12 fertilizer materials may not be guaranteed and must be listed in
- 13 a caution or warning statement with appropriate percentages of
- 14 each plant food.
- The following is an example of an acceptable caution or
- 16 warning statement for a soil or plant amendment offered for sale
- 17 containing fertilizer materials below the plant food
- 18 requirements of 3 MCAR S 1.0327:
- "CAUTION. This product may contain _____ percent nitrogen,
- 20 ____ percent calcium, and ___ percent zinc. This information
- 21 should be taken into consideration when the product is used in
- 22 conjunction with commercial fertilizer or when sensitive crops
- 23 or plants are involved."
- 3. Sewage sludge which is applied to a landspreading site
- 25 must have a sewage sludge analysis containing the information
- 26 listed in a. to g. All analytical values except pH and total
- 27 solids must be recorded on a dry weight basis. The most recent
- 28 sewage sludge analysis, in written or printed form, must be
- 29 supplied to the owner, renter, or lessee of a landspreading site
- 30 before sewage sludge is spread.
- 31 a. Percentage of total solids.
- 32 b. Volatile solids as a percentage of total solids.
- 33 c. pH.
- d. Percentage of nitrogen, including the percentages
- 35 of kjeldahl, ammonia, and in the case of aerobically digested
- 36 and composted sewage sludge, nitrate.

- e. Phosphorus and potassium, expressed as percentages
- 2 of available phosphoric acid (P_2O_5) and soluble potash (K_2O) .
- f. Total weight of heavy metals, including milligrams
- 4 per kilogram of zinc, copper, lead, nickel, cadmium, chromium,
- 5 mercury, and molybdenum.
- 6 g. Polycholorinated biphenyls expressed as milligrams
- 7 per kilogram.
- 8 4. For packaged soil or plant amendments or sewage sludge
- 9 offered for sale, the information required in 1. or 2. must be
- 10 in a readable and conspicuous form and must meet one of the
- 11 following requirements:
- a. appear on the front of the package;
- b. occupy at least the upper one-third of either side
- 14 of the package;
- c. appear on the upper end of the container; or
- d. be printed on a tag and attached to the package.
- 5. For bulk soil or plant amendments or sewage sludge
- 18 offered for sale, the information required in 1. or 2., in
- 19 written or printed form, must accompany delivery and be supplied
- 20 to the purchaser at the time of delivery.
- 21 D. Labeling and labels. Proposed labeling and labels with
- 22 directions for use of the soil or plant amendment must be
- 23 furnished with an application for registration of a soil or
- 24 plant amendment.
- 25 E. Enforcement. The commissioner shall proceed in
- 26 accordance with Minnesota Statutes, section 17.728 upon
- 27 satisfactory evidence that a label or labeling of a soil or
- 28 plant amendment or sewage sludge does not meet the provisions in
- 29 this rule.
