9 ADVANCED NURSING PRACTICE

10 7 MCAR S 5.4000 Purpose.

11 Rules 7 MCAR SS 5.4000-5.4004 establish criteria for  
12 programs of study of advanced nursing practice. Rules 7 MCAR SS  
13 5.4005 and 5.4006 list programs that fulfill the criteria. The  
14 criteria and list are established under Laws of Minnesota 1983,  
15 chapter 221, section 2, subdivision 3a in order to qualify  
16 advanced nursing services for reimbursement by third parties.

17 7 MCAR S 5.4001 Definitions.

18 A. Advanced nursing practice. "Advanced nursing practice"  
19 means the performance of health services by certified registered  
20 nurse anesthetists (CRNA) and certified nurse midwives (CNM) as  
21 defined in Laws of Minnesota 1983, chapter 221, section 2,  
22 subdivision 3a.

23 B. Board. "Board" means the Minnesota Board of Nursing.

24 C. Professional nursing organization for nurse anesthetists.  
25 "Professional nursing organization for nurse anesthetists" means  
26 the American Association of Nurse Anesthetists' Council on  
27 Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Educational Programs/Schools  
28 which accredits the programs of study and the American  
29 Association of Nurse Anesthetists' Council on Certification  
30 which certifies nurse anesthetists.

31 D. Professional nursing organization for nurse midwives.  
32 "Professional nursing organization for nurse midwives" means the  
33 American College of Nurse Midwives of which the Division of  
34 Accreditation accredits the programs of study and the Division  
35 of Certification certifies the nurse midwives.

1 E. Program of study. "Program of study" means an organized  
2 set of classes which include theory and clinical practice  
3 designed to prepare registered nurses for advanced practice as  
4 nurse anesthetists or nurse midwives.

5 7 MCAR S 5.4002 Criteria for inclusion on list of programs of  
6 study.

7 In order to be included on the lists found in 7 MCAR SS  
8 5.4005 and 5.4006, a program of study must consist of subject  
9 matter beyond that required for registered nurse licensure and  
10 meet one of the following criteria:

11 A. programs preparing nurse anesthetists must be accredited  
12 by the Council on Accreditation of Nurse Anesthesia Education  
13 Programs/Schools; or

14 B. programs preparing nurse midwives must be accredited by  
15 the Division of Accreditation, American College of Nurse  
16 Midwives.

17 7 MCAR S 5.4003 How a program of study may demonstrate  
18 compliance with the criteria.

19 A program of study which has submitted written evidence  
20 that it meets the criteria listed in 7 MCAR S 5.4002 shall be  
21 included on the list. Such evidence shall include a copy of the  
22 curriculum and a copy of the official notification that the  
23 program received accreditation status by the required  
24 organization.

25 7 MCAR S 5.4004 Maintenance of lists.

26 A. List updating. Each January and July the board shall add  
27 to the lists programs which have met the criteria within the  
28 previous six months and remove from the lists programs which no  
29 longer meet the criteria.

30 B. New accreditations. Upon receipt of notification by a  
31 professional nursing organization that a program of study has  
32 received accreditation, that program shall be added to the list  
33 the next time the list is updated.
