7 Rules as Adopted

8 11 MCAR S 1.8025 Regulatory permits and fees.

9 Any person engaged in the purchase, sale, or use for any
10 purpose other than personal consumption of intoxicating
11 alcoholic beverages or ethyl alcohol, shall obtain the
12 appropriate regulatory permit and identification card from the
13 commissioner as provided in this rule. The fee for each permit,
14 other than one issued to a state or federal agency, is \$12 and
15 shall be submitted together with the appropriate application
16 form provided by the commissioner. Identification cards and
17 permits shall be issued for a period coinciding with that of the
18 appropriate state or municipal license and are not
19 transferable. In instances where there is no annual license
20 period, cards and permits shall expire one year after the date
21 of issuance. The authority to engage in the purchase, sale, or
22 use granted by the card or permit may be revoked by the
23 commissioner upon evidence of a violation by the holder of such
24 a card or permit of any of the provisions of Minnesota Statutes
25 , chapter 340, or any rule of the commissioner made pursuant to
26 law.

27 In order to coordinate the expiration date of permits and
28 cards with that of the appropriate state or municipal license,
29 permits and cards issued in January 1985 in conjunction with
30 state or municipal licenses expiring prior to July 1, 1985,
31 shall be issued for a term extending until the expiration date
32 of the license in 1986. Permits and cards issued in January
33 1985 in conjunction with state or municipal licenses expiring
34 after June 30, 1985, shall be issued for a term extending until
35 the expiration date of the license in 1985. The fee for cards
36 and permits issued during January 1985 for periods of more or

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1 less than one year shall be prorated at \$1 per month. Subsequent
2 renewals shall be for a 12-month period.

4 D. State or federal agency permits. Permits for state or
5 federal agencies shall be issued without charge.

7 11 MCAR S 1.8058 Delivery.

8 Licensed or authorized "off-sale" retail liquor dealers and
9 no other class of dealers may make deliveries of intoxicating
10 liquor from their stores to the residence of a purchaser or
11 other location, provided however, that such delivery shall be
12 made only to a person ~~18~~ 19 or more years of age; and provided
13 further, that such delivery shall not be made to beer taverns or
14 other public or private place in violation of law or ordinance.

16 D. Open stock deliveries prohibited. Only alcoholic
17 beverages ordered and packed at the store for delivery shall be
18 carried in the delivery vehicle.

19 11 MCAR S 1.8084 Transportation.

20 Only common carriers or duly licensed Minnesota manufacturers
21 or wholesale distributors shall transport distilled spirits,
22 wine, ethyl alcohol, or malt beverages into this state.

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24 Effective date. Rules 11 MCAR SS 1.8025 D. and 1.8084 A.,
25 relating to the repeal of vehicle permits, are effective July 1,
26 1984, or five days after final publication in the State
27 Register, whichever is later.
