7 4 MCAR S 13.028 Licensing of peace officers.

8 A.-C. [Unchanged.]

9 D. Licensing fee. The appropriate licensing fee is \$15 if
10 the licensee is to be licensed for 30 to 36 months; \$10 if the
11 licensee is to be licensed for at least 18 months but less than
12 30 months; and \$5 if the licensee is to be licensed for at least
13 six months but less than 18 months. No fee is owing if the
14 applicant is to be licensed for less than six months.

16 4 MCAR S 13.030 License renewal.

17 A. and B. [Unchanged.]

18 C. Certificate of renewal. The executive director shall
19 issue a certificate of renewal, which is valid for three years,
20 to each applicant who has submitted the appropriate fee on or
21 before June 30 of the year when the license becomes due for
22 renewal and also completed the required hours of continuing
23 education.

24 1. The appropriate fees are:

- 25 a. \$15 for renewal of a peace officer license;
- 26 b. \$7.50 for renewal of a part-time peace officer
- 27 license; and
- 28 c. \$15 for renewal of a constable license.

29 2. The required hours of continuing education are:

- 30 a. No hours for any part-time peace officer or for a
- 31 peace officer or constable who has been licensed for less than
- 32 six months;
- 33 b. Sixteen hours for a peace officer or constable who
- 34 has been licensed for at least six months but less than 18
- 35 months, no more than two of which consist of on-line shooting;

1 c. Thirty-two hours for a peace officer or constable
2 who has been licensed for at least 18 months but less than 30
3 months, no more than four of which consist of on-line shooting;
4 and

5 d. Forty-eight hours for a peace officer or constable
6 who has been licensed for at least 30 months, no more than six
7 of which consist of on-line shooting.

9 4 MCAR S 13.031 Licensing of part-time peace officers.

11 I. Issuance of license. The executive director shall issue
12 a part-time peace officer license to a provisionally licensed
13 part-time peace officer who has passed the part-time peace
14 officer licensing examination, submitted a written application
15 for licensure, and paid the appropriate licensing fee. The
16 period of initial licensure is determined by the initial letter
17 of the licensee's surname, the date of expiration being
18 determined by the provisions of 4 MCAR S 13.030 A. The
19 appropriate licensing fee is \$7.50 if the license is valid for
20 at least 30 months but less than 36 months; \$5 if it is valid
21 for at least 18 months but less than 30 months; and \$2.50 if it
22 is valid for at least six months but less than 18 months. No
23 fee is required if the applicant is to be licensed for less than
24 six months.

28 G. Issuance of license. The executive director shall issue
29 a constable license to a provisionally licensed constable who
30 has passed the constable licensing examination, submitted a
31 written application for licensure, and paid the appropriate
32 licensing fee. The period of initial licensure is determined by
33 the initial letter of the licensee's surname, the date of
34 expiration being determined by the provisions of 4 MCAR S 13.030
35 A. The appropriate licensing fee is \$15 if the license is valid

1 for at least 30 months but less than 36 months; \$10 if it is
2 valid for at least 18 months but less than 30 months, and \$5 if
3 it is valid for at least six months but less than 18 months. No
4 fee is required if the applicant is to be licensed for less than
5 six months.
