- 8 Chapter-7002-applies Parts 7002.0010 to 7002.0100 apply to
- 9 all persons required to obtain a permit from the Minnesota
- 10 Pollution Control Agency as described in part 7001.0020
- ll (permanent rules, scope), items 67-E7-F7-H7 I7 and J.
- 12 7002.0020 DEFINITIONS.
- 13 Subpart 1. Scope. For the purposes of this chapter the
- 14 terms defined in this part have the meanings given them.
- 15 Subp. 2. Agency. "Agency" means the Minnesota Pollution
- 16 Control Agency.
- 17 Subp. 3. Air pollution control equipment. "Air pollution
- 18 control equipment" means a device used to prevent, abate, or
- 19 control air pollution.
- 20 Subp. 4. Director. "Director" means the executive
- 21 director and chief executive officer of the Minnesota Pollution
- 22 Control Agency.
- 23 Subp. 5. Indirect source. "Indirect source" means a
- 24 facility, building, structure, or installation which attracts or
- 25 may attract mobile source activity that results in emissions of
- 26 a pollutant for which there is a state standard.
- 27 Subp. 6. Major emission facility. "Major emission
- 28 facility" means a facility having potential emissions of 100
- 29 tons per year or more of sulfur dioxide or particulate matter.
- 30 Subp. 7. National-Pollutant-Discharge-Elimination-System
- 31 (NPDES):--"National-Pollutant-Discharge-Elimination-System
- 32 (NPDES)"-has-the-meaning-given-it-in-part-7001:1020-(permanent
- 33 rules;-NPDES-permits);-subpart-19:
- 34 Subp:-8: Nonattainment area. "Nonattainment area" means a
- 35 geographical region that has been designated by the Minnesota

- 3 Subp.-9.--State-disposal-system-permit.--"State-disposal
- 4 system-permit"-means-a-permit-for-a-disposal-system-that-may-be
- 5 constructed-and-operated-without-a-NPDES-permit.
- 6 Subp. 10. 8. Total emission facility. "Total emission
- 7 facility" means an assemblage of all emission sources on
- 8 adjacent property that are under common ownership or control and
- 9 that exist for a common function.
- 10 7002.0030 FEE DETERMINATION.
- 11 The agency shall calculate processing and annual fees based
- 12 upon the schedule in part 7002.0100 or-7002.0110 and shall
- 13 notify the permittee of the amount due prior to each payment
- 14 date.
- 15 7002.0040 PAYMENT OF FEES.
- A person submitting a fee shall make the fee payable to the
- 17 "State-Treasurer Minnesota Pollution Control Agency" and submit
- 18 it to the Director, Division of Air Quality; -or-Director,
- 19 Division-of-Water-Quality, as appropriate for the type of
- 20 permitted activity.
- 21 7002.0050 APPLICATION FEE.
- A person who applies for a permit to construct, install,
- 23 modify, or operate a facility shall submit with the application
- 24 the appropriate application fee. Failure to submit the fee
- 25 renders the application incomplete and the agency shall suspend
- 26 processing of the application until the fee is received.
- 27 Application fees are nonrefundable.
- 28 7002.0060 PROCESSING FEE.
- 29 A permittee shall pay the applicable processing fee within
- 30 30 days of issuance of the permit by the agency.
- If a facility is a "small business" as defined in Minnesota
- 32 Statutes, section 14.115, subdivision 1, or-a-municipal
- 33 wastewater-treatment-plant-with-an-average-design-flow-of-less
- 34 than-30,000-gallons-per-day, the permittee may request to pay

- 1 the processing fee in annual installments. Annual installments
- 2 are determined by dividing the processing fee into equal annual
- 3 payments based on the term of the permit. The first payment
- 4 shall be made within 30 days of issuance of the permit and
- 5 annually thereafter on the anniversary of issuance. A facility
- 6 that qualifies as a "small business" must provide proof of that
- 7 status upon application for a permit.
- 8 7002.0070 ANNUAL FEE.
- 9 All persons required to obtain a permit shall pay an annual
- 10 fee for enforcement of applicable statutes and rules except as
- 11 provided in parts part 7002.0100 and-7002.0110. The annual fee
- 12 shall be paid within 30 days of receipt of an invoice from the
- 13 agency.
- 14 7002.0080 NOTIFICATION OF ERROR.
- A person who thinks that a basic processing fee, additional
- 16 processing fee, or annual fee for a specific facility is in
- 17 error shall provide written notice of the error to the director
- 18 of the Division of Air Quality or-the-director-of-the-Division
- 19 of-Water-Quality,-as-appropriate, along with the assessed fee.
- 20 If the director of the Division of Air Quality or-the-Division
- 21 of-Water-Quality finds, upon reviewing the data, that the
- 22 assessed fee was in error, the overpayment shall be refunded to
- 23 the permittee or credited to the permittee's account.
- 24 7002.0090 LATE PAYMENT FEE.
- The permittee shall pay a late payment fee of 20 percent of
- 26 the payment due for failure to make payment within 30 days of a
- 27 payment date. The permittee shall pay an additional ten percent
- 28 of the original payment due for each 30-day period or portion
- 29 thereof that the payment is late.
- 30 7002.0100 AIR QUALITY PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE.
- 31 Subpart 1. Scope. The fees established in this part are
- 32 applicable to facilities and indirect sources which require an
- 33 air emission facility permit under part 7001.1210 (permit rules,
- 34 air emission facility permits) or an indirect source permit

- 1 under part 7001.1270 (permit rules, indirect source permits).
- 2 For the purpose of this part, the terms used have the meanings
- 3 given them in part 7005.0100 (air pollution control rules,
- 4 definitions).
- 5 Subp. 2. Application fee. A person making application for
- 6 an air emission facility permit or an indirect source permit
- 7 shall submit with the application an application fee of \$50.
- 8 Subp. 3. Basic processing fees. The permittee shall pay
- 9 the following basic processing fees for the applicable permit
- 10 activity:
- 11 A. \$900 for the construction of an indirect source;
- B. \$900 for the construction or reconstruction of a
- 13 major emission facility;
- 14 C. \$300 for the construction or reconstruction of an
- 15 emission facility other than a major emission facility;
- D. \$300 for the modification of a major emission
- 17 facility or installation of air pollution control equipment at a
- 18 major emission facility;
- 19 E. \$100 for the modification of an emission facility
- 20 other than a major emission facility or installation of air
- 21 pollution control equipment at an emission facility other than a
- 22 major emission facility;
- F. \$450 for the reissuance of a major emission
- 24 facility permit; and
- G. \$150 for the reissuance of an emission facility
- 26 permit other than a major emission facility.
- For purposes of this subpart, activities as described in
- 28 items D and E that occur during the last year of the term of a
- 29 permit will be addressed along with the reissuance of the permit
- 30 for a new term. The agency shall waive the fee for items D and
- 31 E and only assess a reissuance fee and applicable additional
- 32 processing fees.
- 33 Subp. 4. Additional processing fees. In addition to the
- 34 basic processing fees required in subpart 3, the permittee shall
- 35 pay the following additional processing fees, if applicable:
- A. \$500 for a major stationary source, as defined in

- 1 Code of Federal Regulations, title 40, section 51.18(j)(1)(iv),
- 2 as amended through June 25, 1982, located in a nonattainment
- 3 area;
- B. \$150 for an emission facility that is subject to
- 5 the federal prevention of significant deterioration requirements
- 6 as established in Code of Federal Regulations, title 40, section
- 7 51.24;
- 8 C. \$50 for an emission facility that is subject to
- 9 the federal new source performance standards established in Code
- 10 of Federal Regulations, title 40, part 60;
- 11 D. \$150 for an emission facility that must apply best
- 12 available control technology as required under Code of Federal
- 13 Regulations, title 40, section 51.24;
- 14 E. \$250 for evaluation of air emissions containing
- 15 pollutants for which no ambient air quality standard has been
- 16 established under part 7005.0080 (state ambient air quality
- 17 standards) and which have the potential to be injurious to human
- 18 health;
- 19 F. \$150 for dispersion modeling review; and
- 20 G. \$150 for each performance test review.
- 21 Subp. 5. Annual fees. All persons required to obtain an
- 22 air emission facility permit shall pay the following applicable
- 23 annual fee:
- A.- \$650 for a major emission facility; or
- B. \$150 for an emission facility other than a major
- 26 emission facility.
- The agency shall not charge an annual fee for an emission
- 28 facility with potential emissions of a single pollutant of more
- 29 than 25 tons per year but less than 50 tons per year unless the
- 30 facility also discharges lead to the ambient air.
- 31 Subp. 6. General permits. The agency shall not charge
- 32 processing or annual fees for permits issued as a general permit
- 33 under part 7001.0210 (permit rules).
