7 3300.3300 OPPORTUNITIES INDUSTRIALIZATION CENTERS; JOB TRAINING.

8 Subpart 1. Purpose. The purpose of this part is to define
9 "economically disadvantaged" for the purpose of job training and
10 related services through opportunities industrialization centers
11 according to Minnesota Statutes, section 268.61.

12 Subp. 2. Economically disadvantaged, defined. The term
13 "economically disadvantaged" means an individual who:

14 A. receives, or is a member of a family which
15 receives, cash welfare payments under a federal, state, or local
16 welfare program;

17 B. has, or is a member of a family which has,
18 received a total family income for the six-month period prior to
19 application for the program involved (exclusive of unemployment
20 compensation, child support payments, and welfare payments)
21 which, in relation to family size, was not in excess of the
22 higher of the poverty level determined in accordance with
23 criteria established by the director of the Office of Management
24 and Budget, or 70 percent of the lower living standard income
25 level;

26 C. is receiving food stamps pursuant to the Food
27 Stamp Act of 1977;

28 D. is a foster child on behalf of whom state or local
29 government payments are made; or

30 E. in cases permitted by regulation of the Secretary
31 of the Department of Labor, is an adult handicapped individual
32 whose own income meets the requirements of item A or B, but who
33 is a member of a family whose income does not meet those
34 requirements.
