7 Rules as Adopted

8 3515.4621 AUTO AND TRUCK DISMANTLING.

9 An applicant for an entrance license to teach the
10 vocational program of auto and truck dismantling at a secondary
11 school must complete either items A or B and C.

12 A. The applicant must have a bachelor's degree in
13 industrial education or industrial arts, and the following work
14 experience:

15 (1) 600 hours of auto and truck dismantling
16 yardwork experience;

17 (2) 600 hours of auto and truck salvage inventory
18 and warehouse experience;

19 (3) 600 hours of auto and truck salvage sales
20 counter management experience; and

21 (4) 1,200 hours of auto and truck trade
22 experience pertinent to auto and truck dismantling such as auto
23 and truck mechanic, auto and truck rebuilder, auto and truck
24 sales and service, and auto and truck sales or new/rebuilt parts
25 sales management.

26 B. The applicant must have 6,000 hours of work
27 experience as follows:

28 (1) 1,200 hours of auto and truck dismantling
29 yardwork experience;

30 (2) 1,200 hours of auto and truck salvage
31 inventory and warehouse experience;

32 (3) 1,200 hours of auto and truck salvage sales
33 counter management experience; and

34 (4) 2,400 hours of auto and truck trade
35 experience pertinent to auto and truck dismantling such as auto
36 and truck mechanic, auto and truck rebuilder, auto and truck

1 sales and service, and auto and truck sales or new/rebuilt parts
2 sales management.

3 C. An applicant must meet the requirements on the
4 industrial education portion of the secondary licensure chart in
5 part 3515.9911. Option B on the industrial education portion of
6 the chart is not an option for this license.
