- 7 2605.0100 SCOPE OF AUTHORITY.
- 8 Parts 2605.0100 to 2605.0400 2605.0500 apply to all
- 9 licensed insurers and rate service, data service, or other
- 10 organizations that make insurance policy form or rate filings
- ll required by statute. They are adopted pursuant to authority
- 12 granted under Minnesota Statutes, sections 45.023 and 60A.14,
- 13 subdivision 1, paragraph (c), clause (14).
- 14 2605.0200 FILING FEES FOR CASUALTY AND PROPERTY INSURANCE.
- A \$10 filing fee applies to the following filing of rates,
- 16 rules, policies, or endorsements relating to casualty or
- 17 property insurance:
- 18 A. Rates and rules pertaining to the same kind or
- 19 line of insurance and submitted together are subject to a single
- 20 filing fee.
- 21 B. Policy forms and endorsements pretaining to the
- 22 same kind of insurance and submitted together are subject to a
- 23 single filing fee.
- C. Simultaneous identical filings by other insurers
- 25 within a group or fleet of companies are subject to separate
- 26 filing fees.
- D. Deviations from, including effective date change,
- 28 or nonadoption of, rate service or data service organization
- 29 filings are subject to filing fees.
- 30 E. Policy forms, endorsements, and rate filings made
- 31 by the Minnesota Automobile Insurance Plan or the FAIR Plan are
- 32 subject to filing fees.
- F. The following kinds of worker's compensation
- 34 filings:
- 35 (1) schedule of rates;

- 1 (2) rate deviation;
- 2 (3) schedule rating plans;
- 3 (4) dividend plans;
- 4 (5) policy forms;
- 5 (6) endorsements; and
- 6 (7) retrospective rating plans.
- 7 2605.0300 LIFE AND HEALTH INSURANCE.
- 8 A \$10 filing fee applies to each filing of policy forms,
- 9 contracts, riders, endorsements, certificates, applications, or
- 10 rates as further specified in items A to H F.
- 11 A. If a single policy or contract filing includes
- 12 riders, endorsements, applications, or other forms designed to
- 13 be issued or used in direct connection with that policy or
- 14 contract, a single fee applies to that filing.
- B. Related endorsements, riders, applications, or
- 16 other forms submitted as a single filing, when the policy or
- 17 contract is not being filed, are subject to one filing fee.
- 18 C. Each rate filing or rate revision is subject to a
- 19 filing fee.
- D. Group insurance policy filings, including related
- 21 certificates, applications, or other forms are subject to a
- 22 single filing fee.
- 23 E. Filings made by the Minnesota Comprehensive Health
- 24 Association are subject to filing fees.
- 25 F. When an insurer or the Minnesota Comprehensive
- 26 Health Association fails to respond to an objection or inquiry
- 27 within 90 days, a resubmission is required if action by the
- 28 Department of Commerce is subsequently requested. An additional
- 29 filing fee is required for the resubmission.
- 30 2605.0400 PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL POLICY FORM AND RATE
- 31 FILINGS.
- 32 The provisions in items A to E apply to all insurance
- 33 policy form and rate filings required by statute.
- A. A multipurpose form which can be used with more
- 35 than one kind of policy, is subject to one filing fee.

- B. Filings made to comply with law changes are
- 2 subject to filing fees.
- 3 C. Filings made solely to change a company name or
- 4 officer signature, correct printing errors, or make editorial
- 5 changes are subject to filing fees.
- 6 D. Filings made for the sole purpose of withdrawing
- 7 forms or rates are not subject to filing fees.
- 8 E. Exhibits and supporting data are not subject to
- 9 filing fees.
- 10 F. Subsequent correspondence initiated by the
- ll Department of Commerce relating to a specific filing does not
- 12 require a separate fee, nor does any amended rate or form
- 13 resulting from the correspondence.
- 14 G. Filing fees are not refundable.
- H:--In-unusual-situations-not-specifically-covered-by
- 16 parts-2605.0100-to-2605.0400, the application or nonapplication
- 17 of-a-filing-fee-will-be-determined-by-the-commissioner-of
- 18 commerce.
- 19 2605.0500 EXAMPLES OF FEES PAYABLE.
- The following is a list of specific filing fees applicable
- 21 to certain filings:
- 22 #- A. A filing consisting of a policy form, an
- 23 application, and four endorsements are subject to a filing fee
- 24 of \$10.
- 25 &. Rates and rules submitted together with the
- 26 filing described in item A are subject to an additional \$10
- 27 filing fee, for a total of \$20.
- 28 K. C. A group of three companies submitting identical
- 29 filings are subject to a \$10 filing fee for each company for a
- 30 total of \$30.
- 31 b. D. A filing for nonadoption or only changing the
- 32 effective date of a prior rate service organization filing are
- 33 subject to a \$10 filing fee. If the same filing also includes
- 34 three endorsements replacing those filed on their behalf by the
- 35 rate service organization, the filing fee remains the same.
