6 1700.4800 IMPORTATION OF BISON AND ELK.

7 Subpart 1. Health certificate. A person importing bison,
8 meaning the species *Bison bison*, also known as American bison
9 and buffalo, or elk, meaning the species *Alces alces*, including
10 wapiti, must obtain a health certificate prepared by an
11 accredited veterinarian indicating a negative intradermal
12 tuberculosis test made on the animals within 60 days prior to
13 entry. A copy of the health certificate must be sent to the
14 board of animal health from the chief livestock health official
15 of the state of origin.

16 Subp. 2. Quarantined animals. Bison or elk which are
17 under quarantine or which originate from an area under
18 quarantine may not enter Minnesota.
