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5 Rules as Adopted

6 7045.0219 SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR SMALL QUANTITY GENERATORS OF
7 HAZARDOUS WASTE.

8 Subpart 1. to 4. [Unchanged.]

9 Subp. 5. Management requirements. A small quantity
10 generator shall comply with the following requirements:

11 A. to D. [Unchanged.]

12 E. part 7045.0292, subpart 1, items D to G and as
13 applicable, subpart 4;

14 F. [Unchanged.]

15 G. Either treat or dispose of the hazardous waste in
16 an on-site facility or ensure delivery to an off-site storage,
17 treatment, or disposal facility. The facility used must be:

18 (1) to (4) [Unchanged.]

19 (5) another site belonging to the same owner for
20 consolidation of shipments providing the receiving site complies
21 with parts 7045.0205 to 7045.1030 and the waste is ultimately
22 managed according to subitems (1) to (4);

23 H. Transport hazardous waste in accordance with all
24 applicable requirements of Minnesota Statutes, section 221.033
25 and Code of Federal Regulations, title 49, parts 171 to 179
26 (1983);

27 I. part 7045.0626, subparts 2, 3, and 4; and

28 J. each container is marked with the words "Hazardous
29 Waste."

30 Subp. 6. [Unchanged.]

31 7045.0292 ACCUMULATION OF HAZARDOUS WASTE.

32 Subpart 1. When allowed without a permit. A generator may
33 accumulate hazardous waste on-site or hazardous waste received
34 from off-site pursuant to part 7045.0219, subpart 5, item G,
35 subitem (5) without a permit or without having interim status if:

1 A. all accumulated hazardous waste is, within 90 days
2 of the accumulation start date, shipped off-site to a designated
3 facility or placed in an on-site facility either of which has
4 interim status under parts 7045.0552 to 7045.0642 or has a
5 hazardous waste facility permit issued by the agency; or has a
6 hazardous waste facility permit issued by a state with a
7 hazardous waste program authorized by the Environmental
8 Protection Agency pursuant to Code of Federal Regulations, title
9 40, part 271 (1983); or has a hazardous waste facility permit
10 issued by the Environmental Protection Agency;

11 B. the waste is placed in containers which meet the
12 standards of part 7045.0270, subpart 4 and are managed in
13 accordance with part 7045.0626, subparts 4 to 6; or in tanks
14 provided the generator complies with the requirements of part
15 7045.0628 except part 7045.0628, subpart 3;

16 C. the date upon which each period of accumulation
17 begins is clearly marked and visible for inspection on each
18 container or the generator maintains a record of the
19 accumulation starting date for each tank used for storage and
20 the words "Hazardous Waste" are clearly labeled or marked and
21 visible for inspection on each container or tank;

22 D. to H. [Unchanged.]

23 Subp. 2. to 3. [Unchanged.]

24 Subp. 4. Accumulation of waste by generator. The
25 following apply to generators of hazardous waste:

26 A. A generator may, without a permit or interim
27 status and without complying with subpart 1 provided the
28 generator complies with items B and C, accumulate as much as 55
29 gallons of hazardous waste or one quart of acutely hazardous
30 waste listed in part 7045.0135, subpart 4, item E, in containers
31 located at or near any point of generation where wastes
32 initially accumulate that is under the control of the operator
33 of the process generating the waste.

34 B. The generator must:

35 (1) comply with part 7045.0626, subparts 2, 3,
36 and 4; and

1 (2) mark each container with the words "Hazardous
2 Waste."

3 C. A generator who accumulates either hazardous waste
4 or acutely hazardous waste listed in part 7045.0135, subpart 4,
5 item E in excess of the amounts listed in item A at or near any
6 point of generation must, with respect to the amount of excess
7 waste, comply within three days with subpart 1 or, if
8 applicable, part 7045.0219 or other applicable provisions of
9 this chapter. During the three-day period for compliance the
10 generator must continue to comply with item B. The generator
11 must mark the container holding the excess accumulation of
12 hazardous waste with the date the excess amount began
13 accumulating.

14 7045.0365 TRANSFER FACILITY REQUIREMENTS.

15 Subpart 1. Applicability. A transporter who stores
16 manifested shipments of hazardous waste in containers meeting
17 the requirements of part 7045.0270, subpart 4 at a transfer
18 facility for a period of ten days or fewer is not subject to
19 regulation under parts 7045.0450 to 7045.0642 and a hazardous
20 waste facility permit with respect to the storage of those
21 wastes. The owner or operator must notify the director in
22 writing of his or her activity.

23 Subp. 2. Storage of less than 1,000 kilograms. A
24 transporter who stores less than 1,000 kilograms of hazardous
25 waste is exempt from further regulation.

26 Subp. 3. Storage of 1,000 kilograms or more. A
27 transporter who stores 1,000 kilograms or more of hazardous
28 waste at any time shall comply with the following requirements:

- 29 A. part 7045.0275, subparts 2 and 3;
30 B. part 7045.0292, subpart 1, items E to G;
31 C. part 7045.0556, subpart 5, items A, C, and D;
32 D. part 7045.0558;
33 E. part 7045.0562, subpart 1;
34 F. part 7045.0566, subparts 2 to 4, and 6;
35 G. part 7045.0572, subparts 2 to 6;
36 H. part 7045.0626, subpart 4;

1 I. the transporter shall keep at the transfer
2 facility a written operating record that contains the following
3 information for each shipment:

4 (1) the generator name and manifest document
5 number;

6 (2) the date the waste was received by the
7 transfer facility; and

8 (3) the date the waste was shipped by the
9 transfer facility; and

10 J. storage areas must be protected from unauthorized
11 access and inadvertent damage from vehicles or equipment.

12 7045.0450 FACILITIES GOVERNED BY FACILITY STANDARDS.

13 Subpart 1. and 2. [Unchanged.]

14 Subp. 3. Exemptions. Parts 7045.0450 to 7045.0544 do not
15 apply to the following:

16 A. to G. [Unchanged.]

17 H. a transporter storing manifested shipments of
18 hazardous waste in containers meeting the requirements of part
19 7045.0270, subpart 4 at a transfer facility for a period of ten
20 days or less in compliance with part 7045.0365;

21 I. and J. [Unchanged.]

22 7045.0552 FACILITIES GOVERNED BY INTERIM STATUS.

23 Subpart 1. and 2. [Unchanged.]

24 Subp. 3. Exemptions. The requirements of parts 7045.0522
25 to 7045.0642 do not apply to:

26 A. to G. [Unchanged.]

27 H. A transporter storing manifested shipments of
28 hazardous waste in containers meeting the requirements of part
29 7045.0270, subpart 4 at a transfer facility for a period of ten
30 days or less in compliance with part 7045.0365.

31 I. and J. [Unchanged.]

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
