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3 Adopted Rule Relating to Fees

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5 Rule as Adopted

6 3100.2000 FEES.

7 Subpart 1. Application fees. Each applicant for licensure  
8 as a dentist or dental hygienist or for registration as a  
9 registered dental assistant shall submit with a license or  
10 registration application a fee in the following amounts:

- 11 A. dentist application, \$75;  
12 B. dental hygienist application, \$30; and  
13 C. dental assistant application, \$20.

14 Subp. 2. Annual license or registration fees. Each  
15 dentist, dental hygienist, and registered dental assistant shall  
16 submit with an annual license or registration renewal  
17 application a fee as established by the board not to exceed the  
18 following amounts:

- 19 A. dentist, \$45;  
20 B. dental hygienist, \$20; and  
21 C. registered dental assistant, \$14.

22 Subp. 3. Licensure by credentials. Each applicant for  
23 licensure as a dentist or dental hygienist by credentials  
24 pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, section 150A.06, subdivision 4  
25 and part 3100.1400 shall submit with his or her license  
26 application a fee in the following amounts:

- 27 A. dentist, \$275; and  
28 B. dental hygienist, \$80.

29 Subp. 4. Annual license or registration late fee.  
30 Applications for renewal of any license or registration received  
31 after the time specified in part 3100.1700 are subject to a late  
32 fee equal to 50 percent of the annual renewal fee.

33 Subp. 5. Duplicate license or registration fee. Each  
34 licensee or registrant shall submit with a request for issuance  
35 of a duplicate of his or her original license or registration or  
36 of an annual renewal thereof a fee in the following amounts:

1           A. original dentist or dental hygiene license, \$8;  
2 and

3           B. initial and renewal registration certificates and  
4 license renewal certificates, \$6.

5           Subp. 6. Reinstatement fee. No dentist, dental hygienist,  
6 or registered dental assistant whose license or registration has  
7 been suspended or revoked shall have his or her license or  
8 registration reinstated or a new license or registration issued  
9 until he or she has submitted to the board a fee in the  
10 following amount:

11           A. dentist, \$75;

12           B. dental hygienist, \$30; and

13           C. registered dental assistant, \$20.

14           Subp. 7. Application for permission to take dental X  
15 rays. A person applying for permission to take dental X rays  
16 pursuant to part 3100.8400, subpart 2, shall submit with an  
17 application a fee in the amount of \$10.

18           Subp. 8. Application for approval as sponsor of CDE  
19 courses. A person applying for approval as a sponsor of CDE  
20 programs pursuant to part 3100.4200, subpart 2, shall submit  
21 with an application a fee in the amount of \$75.

22           Subp. 9. Affidavit of licensure. Each licensee or  
23 registrant shall submit with a request for an affidavit of  
24 licensure a fee in the amount of \$10.

25           Subp. 10. Refunds. No fee shall be refunded for any  
26 reason except in those cases where the applicant for licensure  
27 or registration is found to be ineligible to take the  
28 examination.
