3100.8400 ASSISTANTS. 6

7 Subpart 1. Permissible duties. Assistants may: perform 8 all those duties not directly related with performing dental 9 treatment or services on patients; retract a patient's cheek, 10 tongue, or other parts of tissue during a dental operation; 11 assist with the placement or removal of a rubber dam and 12 accessories used for its placement and retention, as directed by 13 an operating dentist during the course of a dental operation; 14 remove such debris as is normally created or accumulated during 15 the course of treatment being rendered by a licensed dentist 16 during or after operative procedures by the dentist by the use of vacuum devices, compressed air, mouthwash, and water; provide 17 any assistance, including the placement of articles and topical 18 19 medication in a patient's oral cavity, in response to a specific 20 direction to do so by a licensed dentist who is then and there actually engaged in performing a dental operation as defined in 21 22 the act and who is then actually in a position to give personal supervision to the rendition of this assistance; and aid dental 23 24 hygienists and registered dental assistants in the performance 25 of their duties as defined in subpart 2 and parts 3100.8600 and 3100.8700. 26

8 Subp. 3. Limited registration. A dental assistant, who by 9 virtue of academic achievement which is equal to or greater than 10 that of a registered dental assistant, and is currently 11 qualified in Minnesota in an allied health profession may take dental radiographs under the indirect supervision of a dentist 12 13 if the person complies with the requirements of this subpart. The person shall file with the board a completed application on 14 15 a form furnished by the board and the fee prescribed in part 16 3100.2000, subpart 7. In addition, the person shall submit evidence of the successful completion of a course on dental 17 18 radiographs and of passing an examination. The course must be board-approved. The course shall be equivalent to the dental 19 radiograph courses offered by dental assisting courses approved 20 by the board under part 3100.1300, item B. The examination must 21 be the radiograph part of the examination which is required of 22 registered dental assistant applicants. 23
