6 Rules as Adopted

7 5225.0300 EXPIRATION AND RENEWALS.

8 Subpart 1. [Unchanged.]

9 Subp. 2. Expirations within less than five years.

10 Licenses which have expired less than five years prior to date
11 of application for renewal may be renewed without the necessity
12 of an examination upon filing an application therefor,
13 accompanied by the fee required in part 5225.8600. Applications
14 shall be marked "expired renewal" and do not have to be signed.

15 Subp. 3. Expirations of five years or more. Licenses
16 which have expired five years or more prior to the date of
17 application for renewal may be renewed by filing an application
18 therefor, accompanied by the fee required by part 5225.8600, and
19 passing an examination.

20 5225.8600 FEES.

21 Subpart 1. Generally. Fees for inspections, examinations,
22 and licenses under parts 5225.0100 to 5225.7200 are in subparts
23 2 to 7.

24 Subp. 2. Engineer licenses.

25 A. The fees for a new engineer license application
26 are as follows:

- 27 (1) chief engineer, \$40;
- 28 (2) first class engineer, \$25;
- 29 (3) second class engineer, \$20;
- 30 (4) special engineer, \$15;
- 31 (5) hobby engineer, \$30; and
- 32 (6) pilot, \$20.

33 B. The fees for license renewal under part 5225.0300
34 are as follows:

- 35 (1) chief engineer, \$25;

- 1 (2) first class engineer, \$20;
2 (3) second class engineer, \$15; and
3 (4) special engineer, pilot, \$10.

4 C. The fees for expired renewals under part
5 5225.0300, subpart 2, are as follows:

- 6 (1) chief engineer, \$30;
7 (2) first class engineer, \$25;
8 (3) second class engineer, \$20; and
9 (4) special engineer, pilot, \$15.

10 Subp. 3. Boiler and pressure vessel inspection. The fees
11 for the annual inspections of boilers and the biennial
12 inspections of pressure vessels under Minnesota Statutes,
13 section 183.545, subdivision 3, are as follows:

- 14 A. boiler inaccessible for internal inspection, \$20;
15 B. boiler accessible for internal inspection, \$30;
16 C. boiler internal inspection over 2,000 square feet,
17 \$40;
18 D. boiler internal inspection over 4,000 square feet,
19 \$50;
20 E. boiler internal inspection over 10,000 square
21 feet, \$70;
22 F. boiler requiring internal inspection up to
23 one-half day, \$130;
24 G. pressure vessel for internal inspection, \$20; and
25 H. pressure vessel inaccessible for internal
26 inspection, \$10.

27 Subp. 4. Shop inspections. The fees for shop inspections
28 under Minnesota Statutes, section 183.545, subdivision 3, are as
29 follows:

- 30 A. inspection of two hours or less, \$70;
31 B. one-half day, four hours or less, \$130;
32 supervisor, \$180;
33 C. eight hours or less, \$240; supervisor, \$320; and
34 D. each hour over eight hours, per hour, \$45;
35 supervisor, \$50.

36 Subp. 5. Inspectors. The fees for inspector's

1 examinations, certificates, and endorsements under Minnesota
2 Statutes, section 183.545, subdivisions 6, 7, and 8, are as
3 follows:

- 4 A. national board inspector's exam, \$40;
- 5 B. nuclear endorsement, \$20;
- 6 C. Minnesota certificate of competency, original,
7 \$20; and
- 8 D. Minnesota certificate of competency, renewal, \$15.

9 Subp. 6. Exemption certificates. The fees for exemption
10 certificates under Minnesota Statutes, section 183.57,
11 subdivision 2, are as follows:

- 12 A. first object inspected, \$10; and
- 13 B. each additional object inspected, \$5.

14 Subp. 7. Vessel inspections. The fees for vessel
15 inspections under Minnesota Statutes, section 183.545,
16 subdivision 1, are as follows:

- 17 A. boat under 30 feet, \$30;
- 18 B. boat from 30 to 40 feet, \$40;
- 19 C. boat 40 to 50 feet, \$50; and
- 20 D. boat over 50 feet, \$60.
