- 7 7001.0010 DEFINITIONS.
- 8 Subpart 1. and 2. [Unchanged.]
- 9 Subp. 3. Permit. "Permit" means a discharge, emission,
- 10 and disposal authorization; a construction, installation, or
- 11 operation authorization; and other agency authorizations
- 12 designated "permit" in Minnesota Statutes, chapters 115 and 116,
- 13 including Minnesota Statutes, sections 115.03, subdivision 1;
- 14 115.07; 116.07, subdivision 4a; 116.081; and 116.091. "Permit"
- 15 does not include an "order," "variance," or "stipulation
- 16 agreement" as defined in part 7000.0100 and does not include a
- 17 "certification." However, the exclusion of "certification" from
- 18 the definition of "permit" shall not in any way be considered to
- 19 affect the applicability of parts 7001.0010 to 7001.0210 to the
- 20 processing of certifications by the agency under section 401 of
- 21 the Clean Water Act, United States Code, title 33, section 1341,
- 22 to the extent provided by parts 7001.1400 to 7001.1470.
- Subp. 4. [Unchanged.]
- 24 7001.0020 SCOPE.
- Except as otherwise specifically provided, parts 7001.0010
- 26 to 7001.0210 apply to the following:
- A. to J. [Unchanged.]
- 28 K. The processing of certifications under section 401
- 29 of the Clean Water Act, United States Code, title 33, section
- 30 1341, to the extent provided by parts 7001.1400 to 7001.1470.
- 31 7001.1400 APPLICABILITY.
- Parts 7001.1400 to 7001.1470 govern the processing of
- 33 certifications by the agency under section 401 of the Clean
- 34 Water Act, United States Code, title 33, section 1341

- 1 (hereinafter "section 401 certifications"). Parts 7001.0010 to
- 2 7001.0210 apply to the processing of section 401 certifications
- 3 except as specifically otherwise provided in parts 7001.1400 to
- 4 7001.1470. In applying parts 7001.0010 to 7001.0210 to the
- 5 processing of section 401 certifications, the word "permit"
- 6 shall be construed to mean "section 401 certification" and the
- 7 term "permittee" shall be construed to mean "certificate
- 8 holder." Parts 7000.0100 to 7000.1600, 7001.0010 to 7001.0210,
- 9 and 7001.1400 to 7001.1470 shall be construed to complement each
- 10 other.
- 11 7001.1410 DEFINITIONS.
- 12 Subpart 1. Scope. The definitions in Minnesota Statutes,
- 13 section 115.01 apply to the terms used in parts 7001.1400 to
- 14 7001.1470 unless those terms are defined in this part.
- 15 As used in parts 7001.1400 to 7001.1470, the terms in
- 16 subparts 2 to 4 have the meanings given them.
- 17 Subp. 2. Director. "Director" means the director of the
- 18 Minnesota Pollution Control Agency.
- 19 Subp. 3. Clean Water Act. "Clean Water Act" means the
- 20 federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, commonly
- 21 referred to as the Clean Water Act, United States Code, title
- 22 33, sections 1251 et seq.
- 23 Subp. 4. National pollutant discharge elimination
- 24 system. "National pollutant discharge elimination system" means
- 25 the national program for issuing, modifying, revoking and
- 26 reissuing, terminating, monitoring, and enforcing permits, and
- 27 imposing and enforcing pretreatment requirements under sections
- 28 307, 318, 402, and 405 of the Clean Water Act, United States
- 29 Code, title 33, sections 1317, 1328, 1342, and 1345.
- 30 7001.1420 REQUIREMENT TO APPLY FOR CERTIFICATION.
- Any person who is required by section 401 of the Clean
- 32 Water Act, United States Code, title 33, section 1341, to obtain
- 33 a certification from the state of Minnesota shall make
- 34 application to the agency.

- 1 7001.1430 APPLICATION DEADLINES.
- 2 Part 7001.0040, subparts 1 and 2 apply to applications for
- 3 issuance, modification, revocation and reissuance, or reissuance
- 4 of a section 401 certification, except that the time period
- 5 referenced in part 7001.0040, subpart 1, shall be 90 days
- 6 instead of 180 days.
- 7 7001.1440 PUBLIC NOTICE OF APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY
- 8 DETERMINATION.
- 9 Subpart 1. Public notice required. Except as provided in
- 10 subpart 2, the director shall prepare and issue public notices
- 11 in accordance with the requirements of part 7001.0100, subpart
- 12 4, except that the public comment period shall be established by
- 13 the director on a case-by-case basis after considering the
- 14 scope, nature, and potential impacts on water quality of the
- 15 project. In no event shall the public comment period be less
- 16 than ten days.
- 17 Subp. 2. Exception. The director is not required to
- 18 prepare and distribute a public notice pursuant to part
- 19 7001.0100, subpart 4, if the director finds that a federal
- 20 agency or department has prepared and distributed or will
- 21 prepare and distribute a public notice concerning a section 401
- 22 certification in accordance with the public notice requirements
- 23 applicable to the federal agency or department under federal
- 24 statutes or regulations, so long as the notice is actually
- 25 prepared and distributed.
- 26 7001.1450 FINAL DETERMINATION.
- 27 Subpart 1. Action required. The agency shall make final
- 28 determinations with respect to section 401 certifications by
- 29 taking one of the following actions:
- 30 A. Issue, reissue, revoke and reissue, or modify a
- 31 section 401 certification in accordance with part 7001.0140,
- 32 subpart 1 and upon making a finding that the discharge which is
- 33 the subject of the section 401 certification will comply with
- 34 sections 301, 302, 303, 306, and 307 of the Clean Water Act,
- 35 United States Code, title 33, sections 1311, 1312, 1313, 1316,

- 1 and 1317.
- B. Deny or revoke a section 401 certification upon
- 3 making the findings set forth in part 7001.0140, subpart 2 or
- 4 the findings set forth in subpart 2.
- 5 C. Waive the agency's authority to issue a section
- 6 401 certification in accordance with part 7001.1460.
- 7 Subp. 2. Denial of certification required. The agency
- 8 shall deny a section 401 certification if the agency finds that
- 9 the issuance will result in a discharge of a radiological,
- 10 chemical, or biological warfare agent.
- 11 7001.1460 WAIVER.
- 12 With respect to the discharge that is the subject of the
- 13 application, the agency is considered to have waived its
- 14 authority to issue a section 401 certification under the
- 15 following circumstances:
- 16 A. If the agency notifies the applicant in writing
- 17 that it is waiving the agency's authority to certify the
- 18 project. If issuance of the waiver is conditional, the
- 19 notification shall specify the conditions that must be met.
- B. If the agency fails or refuses to make a final
- 21 determination on an application for a section 401 certification
- 22 within one year after receipt of the application and the
- 23 agency's failure or refusal to act is not a result of the
- 24 applicant's failure or refusal to cure a deficiency in the
- 25 application as required by the director pursuant to part
- 26 7001.0090.
- 27 7001.1470 TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SECTION 401 CERTIFICATIONS.
- Subpart 1. General terms required. A section 401
- 29 certification issued by the agency shall include the following:
- 30 A. The name and address of the certificate holder.
- 31 B. A statement that the agency has examined the
- 32 section 401 certification application and any other information
- 33 furnished by the applicant and bases its certification upon an
- 34 evaluation of this information that is relevant to water quality
- 35 considerations.

- 1 C. A statement that there is reasonable assurance
- 2 that the activity will be conducted in a manner that will not
- 3 violate applicable water quality standards.
- D. The terms and conditions in part 7001.0150, except
- 5 that the provisions of part 7001.0150, subpart 1 do not apply to
- 6 section 401 certifications. In addition to the special
- 7 conditions in part 7001.0150, subpart 2, a section 401
- 8 certification shall contain the special conditions described in
- 9 subpart 2.
- 10 Subp. 2. NPDES conditions. A section 401 certification
- 11 shall contain the special conditions described in part
- 12 7001.1080, subparts 2 to 9, which conditions shall be
- 13 established in the same manner as special conditions are
- 14 established under part 7001.1080 for national pollutant
- 15 discharge elimination system permits.
