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- 5 Rules as Adopted
- 6 4900.1804 SCOPE.
- 7 Parts 4900.1804 to 4900.1808 govern the implementation of
- 8 the shared housing program.
- 9 4900.1805 DEFINITIONS.
- Subpart 1. Scope. The terms used in parts 4900.1804 to
- 11 4900.1808 have the meanings given them in this part.
- 12 Subp. 2. Agency. "Agency" means the Minnesota Housing
- 13 Finance Agency.
- 14 Subp. 3. Applicant. "Applicant" means one or more persons
- 15 or entities who submit an application to the agency for a shared
- 16 housing grant or loan.
- 17 Subp. 4. Application. "Application" means a submittal
- 18 requesting a grant or loan to pay the cost of acquisition,
- 19 construction, or rehabilitation of a structure into a shared
- 20 housing facility for occupancy by low and moderate income
- 21 elderly.
- Subp. 5. Low and moderate income elderly or elderly. "Low
- 23 and moderate income elderly" or "elderly" means persons 55 years
- 24 of age and older with incomes which do not exceed the greater of
- 25 80 percent of the statewide or area median household income as
- 26 estimated by the United States Department of Housing and Urban
- 27 Development.
- Subp. 6. Shared housing program or program. "Shared
- 29 housing program" or "program" means the agency's plan and
- 30 procedures designed to provide grants or loans to housing
- 31 sponsors for the acquisition, construction, or conversion of
- 32 existing structures into shared housing facilities that contain
- 33 from three to 12 private sleeping rooms, with shared cooking
- 34 facilities and common space, for occupancy by low and moderate
- 35 income elderly.

- 1 Subp. 7. Structure. "Structure" means a building to be
- 2 acquired, constructed, or rehabilitated for use as shared
- 3 housing.
- 4 Subp. 8. Shared housing. "Shared housing" means a
- 5 structure for occupancy by the elderly that contains from three
- 6 to 12 private sleeping rooms, shared cooking facilities, and
- 7 common space.
- 8 4900.1806 APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY.
- 9 To be eligible for selection as a recipient of a grant or
- 10 loan, an applicant must satisfy the following requirements:
- 11 A. The applicant must be a housing sponsor as defined
- 12 in part 4900.0010, subpart 13.
- B. The applicant must provide a comprehensive plan
- 14 for providing a shared housing structure, and document the
- 15 ability to successfully maintain the structure in accordance
- 16 with its intended use for a period of time specified by the
- 17 agency. At a minimum this plan must include:
- 18 (1) documentation of the need and desirability of
- 19 the proposed shared housing;
- 20 (2) a description of the applicant's goals and
- 21 objectives for meeting the special needs of the population to be
- 22 served;
- 23 (3) a detailed budget for the acquisition,
- 24 construction, or rehabilitation of the proposed structure;
- 25 (4) documentation of an ability to successfully
- 26 match potential tenants in the shared housing facility;
- 27 (5) documentation of an ability to provide any
- 28 required support and services for the tenants in the shared
- 29 housing facility; and
- 30 (6) documentation of fiscal responsibility and
- 31 the ability to complete the acquisition, construction, or
- 32 rehabilitation of the structure and to maintain the structure in
- 33 accordance with its intended use for a period of time specified
- 34 by the agency.
- 35 4900.1807 STRUCTURE ELIGIBILITY.

- 1 To be eligible for selection for a grant or loan, a
- 2 proposed shared housing facility must satisfy the following
- 3 requirements:
- A. The structure must contain from three to 12
- 5 private sleeping rooms, shared cooking facilities, and shared
- 6 common space.
- 7 B. The structure must provide shared housing for low
- 8 and moderate income elderly.
- 9 C. The structure must provide a physical environment
- 10 that is responsive to the needs of the population to be served.
- 11 D. The structure must comply with applicable state
- 12 and local codes, zoning ordinances, land use provisions and laws.
- 13 E. The structure must be located in Minnesota.
- 14 4900.1808 SELECTION CRITERIA.
- The agency will take the following criteria into
- 16 consideration when determining which applications will be funded:
- 17 A. The amount of experience of the applicant in
- 18 establishing and maintaining shared housing facilities.
- B. The extent to which the grant or loan funds are
- 20 combined with other funds from private or public sources.
- 21 C. The ability of the applicant to proceed promptly
- 22 with the acquisition, construction, or rehabilitation of the
- 23 structure.
- D. The suitability of the proposed structure for its
- 25 intended use, including its location within the community, its
- 26 homelike qualities, and its image and attractiveness.
- 27 E. The documented need for shared housing in the
- 28 proposed location.
- 29 F. The ability of the applicant to maintain the
- 30 facility for its intended use for a period of time specified by
- 31 the agency.
- 32 G. The reasonableness of the cost of acquisition,
- 33 construction, or rehabilitation of the structure.
- 34 H. The location of the proposed facility, so as to
- 35 allow for a reasonable distribution of facilities throughout the

- 1 state.
- 2 I. The extent of community support documented for the
- 3 proposed facility.
- J. The extent to which the applicant uses innovative,
- 5 cost effective techniques in providing the shared housing
- 6 structure and in maintaining it as a desirable place for the
- 7 elderly to reside.
