6 1530.0740 DEFINITIONS.

7 Subpart 1. [Unchanged.]

8 Subp. 2. **Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance.** "Grade A
9 Pasteurized Milk Ordinance" means the "Grade A Pasteurized Milk
10 Ordinance--1978 Recommendations" and the "Grade A Condensed and
11 Dry Milk Products and Condensed and Dry Whey--Supplement I to
12 the Grade A Pasteurized Milk Ordinance 1978 Recommendations,"
13 including all footnotes, appendixes, and published revisions of
14 the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Food
15 and Drug Administration. A copy of this ordinance and all
16 revisions must be filed in the office of the regulatory agency.

18 1530.0820 GRADING PROCEDURE FOR MILK AND CREAM.

19 All milk and cream offered for sale and purchased for
20 manufacturing purposes must meet all grading and inspection
21 standards as published in the Federal Register, volume 50,
22 number 166, pages 34726 to 34729, on Tuesday, August 27, 1985,
23 as stated under the Agricultural Marketing Service "Notice to
24 Revise the Requirements Recommended for Adoption by State
25 Regulatory Agencies Regarding Milk for Manufacturing Purposes
26 and its Production and Processing."
