- 7 5510.1210 TRANSFER OF EXCLUSIVE REPRESENTATIVE STATUS.
- 8 Subpart 1. and 2. [Unchanged.]
- 9 Subp. 3. Notice. The exclusive representative must
- 10 provide advance written notice of the proposed transfer to each
- 11 member of the exclusive representative in the appropriate unit.
- 12 The notice must state the time and location of the meeting or
- 13 meetings to be held by the exclusive representative relating to
- 14 the proposed transfer.
- 15 Subp. 4. Meeting. The exclusive representative must hold
- 16 a meeting or meetings to permit discussion of the proposed
- 17 transfer at a time and location which is reasonably convenient
- 18 for the majority of the members of the exclusive representative
- 19 in the appropriate unit.
- 20 Subp. 5. Election. The exclusive representative must
- 21 conduct a secret ballot election among its members in the
- 22 appropriate unit to determine approval or rejection of the
- 23 proposed transfer in accordance with the constitutional
- 24 requirements of the exclusive representative.
- Subp. 6. Petition. If all employees in the appropriate
- 26 unit have been afforded the opportunity to become members of the
- 27 exclusive representative, and if a majority of the members of
- 28 the exclusive representative voting in the election required by
- 29 subpart 5 vote in favor of the transfer, a petition shall be
- 30 filed by the exclusive representative with the director.
