6 9100.0400 APPLICATION FEES TO PRACTICE VETERINARY MEDICINE.

7 Subpart 1. **Amount.** A person applying for a license to  
8 practice veterinary medicine in this state shall submit to the  
9 Board of Veterinary Medicine a fee of \$185 in the form of a  
10 check or money order payable to the state treasurer. The  
11 application fee received shall support only the application with  
12 which the fee was submitted. A person who applies more than  
13 once shall submit the full application fee with each subsequent  
14 application.

16 9100.0500 RENEWAL FEE.

17 Subpart 1. [Unchanged.]

18 Subp. 2. **Amount.** The annual fee for licensure renewal is  
19 \$30 and must be paid to the executive secretary of the board on  
20 or before March 1 of each year. By January 1 of the year for  
21 which the renewal fee is due, the board will issue a renewal  
22 application to each current licensee to the last address  
23 maintained in the board file. Failure to receive this notice  
24 does not relieve the licensee of the obligation to pay renewal  
25 fees in such a manner that they are received by the board on or  
26 before the renewal date of March 1.

27 Subp. 3. [Unchanged.]

28 Subp. 4. **Late penalty.** An applicant for renewal shall pay  
29 a late penalty of \$20 as well as the renewal fee if the  
30 application for renewal is received after March 1 of the current  
31 year. A renewed license issued after March 1 of any year is  
32 valid only until March 1 of the next succeeding year regardless  
33 of when the renewal fee is received.
