- 32 prior to evaluation of an applicant's qualifications for
- 33 examination and licensure.

- Subpart 1. and 2. [Unchanged.]
- Subp. 3. Fee. The fee for licensure is \$55 for registered
- 16 nurse applicants and \$55 for licensed practical nurse
- 17 applicants, effective November-1,-1986 January 1, 1987. This
- 18 fee must be paid to the board and must be received prior to
- 19 evaluation of an applicant's qualifications for licensure.
- 20 Personal checks are not accepted. Remittance must be in the
- 21 form of United States currency, cashier's check, or money
- 22 order. If for any reason a license is not issued, the fee is
- 23 not refundable.
