- 6 6500.1800 LICENSE EXAMINATION FEE.
- 7 All applications for licensure by examination in this state
- 8 shall be accompanied by a \$75 fee. In the event the applicant
- 9 fails to pass a part of the examination, upon application and
- 10 the payment of an additional fee of \$50, the applicant may
- 11 retake the examination at the time for which the board next
- 12 schedules examinations.
- 13 6500.1900 LICENSE CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE FEE.
- 14 Each applicant who meets all applicable requirements for
- 15 licensure under the act and these rules shall be issued a
- 16 license certificate by the board. The fee for this license
- 17 certificate shall be \$12. Upon proof of loss or damage of an
- 18 original license certificate and payment of an additional \$12
