6 6500.1800 LICENSE EXAMINATION FEE.

7 All applications for licensure by examination in this state
8 shall be accompanied by a \$75 fee. In the event the applicant
9 fails to pass a part of the examination, upon application and
10 the payment of an additional fee of \$50, the applicant may
11 retake the examination at the time for which the board next
12 schedules examinations.

13 6500.1900 LICENSE CERTIFICATE ISSUANCE FEE.

14 Each applicant who meets all applicable requirements for
15 licensure under the act and these rules shall be issued a
16 license certificate by the board. The fee for this license
17 certificate shall be \$12. Upon proof of loss or damage of an
18 original license certificate and payment of an additional \$12
19 fee, a replacement certificate may be issued by the board.

20 Each applicant who meets all applicable requirements for
21 use of drugs in patient care shall be issued a certificate by
22 the board. The fee for this certificate is \$10. A replacement
23 certificate may be issued by the board.

24 6500.2100 RECIPROCITY.

25 Subpart 1. [Unchanged.]

26 Subp. 2. **Equivalency of state requirements.** In accordance
27 with Minnesota Statutes, section 148.57, subdivision 2, another
28 state's licensure requirements shall be deemed to be equivalent
29 to Minnesota's if the state requires that each applicant:

30 A. to D. [Unchanged.]

31 A fee of \$75 shall accompany every application for
32 licensure by reciprocity.

33 6500.2700 OPTOMETRIST EMERITUS REGISTRATION.

34 Subpart 1. to 4. [Unchanged.]

1 Subp. 5. Renewal cycle or fees. Being registered as an
2 emeritus optometrist will not subject the person to the annual
3 license renewal cycle or renewal fee.

4 Each applicant who meets all requirements for registration
5 as emeritus optometrist shall be issued a certificate. The fee
6 for this certificate is \$10. A replacement certificate may be
7 issued by the board.
