- 5 Rules as Adopted
- 6 7002.0100 AIR QUALITY PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE.
- 7 Subpart 1. [Unchanged.]
- 8 Subp. 2. Application fee. A person making application for
- 9 an air emission facility permit or an indirect source permit
- 10 shall submit with the application an application fee of \$80.
- 11 Subp. 3. Basic processing fees. The permittee shall pay
- 12 the following basic processing fees for the applicable permit
- 13 activity:
- A. \$1,440 for the construction of an indirect source;
- B. \$1,440 for the construction or reconstruction of a
- 16 major emission facility;
- 17 C. \$480 for the construction or reconstruction of an
- 18 emission facility other than a major emission facility;
- D. \$480 for the modification of a major emission
- 20 facility or installation of air pollution control equipment at a
- 21 major emission facility;
- 22 E. \$160 for the modification of an emission facility
- 23 other than a major emission facility or installation of air
- 24 pollution control equipment at an emission facility other than a
- 25 major emission facility;
- 26 F. \$720 for the reissuance of a major emission
- 27 facility permit; and
- 28 G. \$240 for the reissuance of an emission facility
- 29 permit other than a major emission facility.
- For purposes of this subpart, activities as described in
- 31 items D and E that occur during the last year of the term of a
- 32 permit will be addressed along with the reissuance of the permit
- 33 for a new term. The agency shall waive the fee for items D and
- 34 E and only assess a reissuance fee and applicable additional
- 35 processing fees.

- 1 Subp. 4. Additional processing fees. In addition to the
- 2 basic processing fees required in subpart 3, the permittee shall
- 3 pay the following additional processing fees, if applicable:
- A. \$800 for a major stationary source, as defined in
- 5 Code of Federal Regulations, title 40, section 51.18(j)(1)(iv),
- 6 as amended through June 25, 1982, located in a nonattainment
- 7 area;
- B. \$240 for an emission facility that is subject to
- 9 the federal prevention of significant deterioration requirements
- 10 as established in Code of Federal Regulations, title 40, section
- 11 51.24;
- 12 C. \$80 for an emission facility that is subject to
- 13 the federal new source performance standards established in Code
- 14 of Federal Regulations, title 40, part 60;
- D. \$240 for an emission facility that must apply best
- 16 available control technology as required under Code of Federal
- 17 Regulations, title 40, section 51.24;
- 18 E. \$400 for evaluation of air emissions containing
- 19 pollutants for which no ambient air quality standard has been
- 20 established under part 7005.0080 (state ambient air quality
- 21 standards) and which have the potential to be injurious to human
- 22 health;
- F. \$240 for dispersion modeling review; and
- 24 G. \$240 for each performance test review.
- 25 Subp. 5. Annual fees. All persons required to obtain an
- 26 air emission facility permit shall pay the following applicable
- 27 annual fee:
- A. \$1,040 for a major emission facility; or
- B. \$240 for an emission facility other than a major
- 30 emission facility.
- 31 The agency shall not charge an annual fee for an emission
- 32 facility with potential emissions of a single pollutant of more
- 33 than 25 tons per year but less than 50 tons per year unless the
- 34 facility also discharges lead to the ambient air.
