- 7680.0100 PURPOSE. 8
- Parts 7680.0100 to 7680.0200 are adopted under the 9
- authority of Minnesota Statutes, section 1163-035 216C.02, 10
- subdivision 2 3, to establish criteria and procedures for 11
- granting financial assistance to Minnesota public school 12
- districts, cities, counties, and towns for conducting building 13
- energy audits under the state's cost-share maxi-audit program. 14
- 7680.0110 DEFINITIONS. 15
- 16 Subpart 1. Scope. For the purposes of parts 7680.0100 to
- 7680.0200, the following terms have the meanings given them. 17
- Subp. 2. Authorized cost-share maxi-auditor. "Authorized 18
- 19 cost-share maxi-auditor" is a person who has met the
- requirements of part 7680.0140. 20
- Subp. 3. Building. "Building" means any existing, 21
- separate, enclosed, heated structure owned and operated by a 22
- municipality. 23
- Subp. 4. Cost-share maxi-audit. "Cost-share maxi-audit" 24
- means a detailed engineering analysis of a building and its 25
- energy using systems, including the plumbing, lighting, heating, 26
- ventilating, and air conditioning systems. The primary 27
- objective of a cost-share maxi-audit is to identify and quantify 28
- the economic and engineering feasibility of energy conservation 29
- 30 measures for a building and its energy using systems.
- Subp. 5. Cost-share maxi-audit manual or manual. 31
- "Cost-share maxi-audit manual" or "manual" means the manual 32
- incorporated by reference in part 7680.0200. 33
- Subp. 6. Cost-share maxi-audit report. "Cost-share 34
- maxi-audit report" means a written document prepared according 35

- 1 to the cost-share maxi-audit manual as the result of a
- 2 cost-share maxi-audit of a building.
- 3 Subp. 7. Department. "Department" means the Minnesota
- 4 Department of Public Service.
- 5 Subp. 8. Designated-official:--"Designated-official"-means
- 6 a-person-designated-by-a-municipality-or-joint-power-of
- 7 municipalities-to-sign-a-grant-for-cost-share-maxi-audit
- 8 services.
- 9 Subpr-9: Municipality. "Municipality" means a public
- 10 school district, statutory or home rule charter city, county, or
- 11 town in Minnesota, or joint power of these.
- 12 7680.0120 ELIGIBILITY.
- 13 All municipalities are eligible for cost-share maxi-audit
- 14 grants for buildings which they own and operate. A building for
- 15 which a municipality has received cost-share maxi-audit funds is
- 16 not eligible for another cost-share maxi-audit grant until five
- 17 years after the date of the previous cost-share maxi-audit grant
- 18 payment.
- 19 7680.0130 COST-SHARE MAXI-AUDIT REQUIREMENTS.
- 20 Cost-share maxi-audit reports shall be prepared in
- 21 accordance with the manual incorporated by reference in part
- 22 7680.0200.
- 23 7680.0140 COST-SHARE MAXI-AUDITOR AUTHORIZATION.
- 24 An authorized cost-share maxi-auditor is a person who is a
- 25 professional electrical or mechanical engineer or architect
- 26 registered in Minnesota and who has:
- A. agreed to abide by the requirements of this part
- 28 when conducting cost-share maxi-audits;
- B. agreed to attend mandatory cost-share maxi-audit
- 30 information and training sessions conducted by the department;
- 31 C. signed and submitted to the department, upon
- 32 completion of the mandatory cost-share maxi-audit training, the
- 33 Authorization Agreement for Cost-Share Maxi-Auditors which is
- 34 provided in the manual and is available upon request from the

- 1 department; and
- D. agreed to make appropriate changes and additions
- 3 to a cost-share maxi-audit report within 30 days after being
- 4 sent written notification from the department of the required
- 5 changes and additions.
- 6 These requirements must be adhered to in order for a person
- 7 to maintain authorized cost-share maxi-auditor status.
- 8 7680.0150 APPLICATION.
- 9 Subpart 1. Process. The municipality must submit to the
- 10 department an application for cost-share maxi-audit funds on a
- 11 form provided by the department. This application must include
- 12 the following:
- 13 A. the municipality's name and address;
- B. the name and address of the building;
- 15 C. the area of the building in square feet;
- D. the building audit status: previously
- 17 maxi-audited or unaudited;
- 18 E. the date of the application; and
- F. a contact person's name, title, and telephone
- 20 number.
- 21 Subp. 2. Application period. The department will process
- 22 applications in accordance with part 7680.0190, subpart 1, until
- 23 all funds have been encumbered.
- 24 7680.0160 CONTRACT PROCESS.
- 25 Subpart 1. Application review. Upon receipt of an
- 26 eligible application from a municipality, the department will
- 27 determine the funding limits for each building according to part
- 28 7680.0190, subpart 2, and will prepare a cost-share maxi-audit
- 29 grant contract for each building.
- 30 Subp. 2. General. The department will send the prepared
- 31 contract to the applicant for signatures by two of the
- 32 applicant's officials authorized to sign contracts. Grant
- 33 contracts must be signed and returned to the department within
- 34 45 days of the department's mailing date to the applicant. If
- 35 the grant contract has not been returned within 45 days, the

- 1 funds may be redistributed to other applicants. After complete
- 2 execution of the grant contract by the state of Minnesota, the
- 3 department will send the municipality a copy of the fully
- 4 executed contract, required scope of work, and a list of
- 5 authorized cost-share maxi-auditors.
- 6 7680.0170 COST-SHARE MAXI-AUDIT REPORT REVIEW.
- 7 The department will review cost-share maxi-audit reports to
- 8 verify that all requirements of the manual have been fulfilled.
- 9 If the department review identifies any requirements that have
- 10 not been fulfilled, the department will notify both the grantee
- 11 and the authorized cost-share maxi-auditor of the necessary
- 12 changes and additions. The department may conduct an on-site
- 13 verification of the data contained in the cost-share maxi-audit
- 14 report. When the cost-share maxi-audit report has been
- 15 determined to fulfill all requirements, notice of acceptance
- 16 will be sent to the grantee.
- 17 7680.0180 REIMBURSEMENT.
- To be reimbursed for the funds approved in part 7680.0190,
- 19 subpart 2, the following conditions must be met:
- 20 A. The municipality must not have contracted for or
- 21 begun work before the fully executed grant contract was received
- 22 by the municipality.
- B. The cost-share maxi-audit must have been conducted
- 24 by an authorized cost-share maxi-auditor.
- 25 C. The municipality must have submitted to the
- 26 department no later than 90 days before the expiration date of
- 27 the contract, the following:
- 28 (1) one copy of the cost-share maxi-audit report
- 29 signed by an authorized cost-share maxi-auditor for each
- 30 building that was awarded a cost-share maxi-audit grant; and
- 31 (2) one copy of the invoice for the cost-share
- 32 maxi-audit work, itemized by building.
- 33 D. The cost-share maxi-audit report must have met the
- 34 requirements of the manual.

- 1 7680.0190 FUNDING.
- 2 Subpart 1. Priorities. The department will process grant
- 3 applications that comply with parts 7680.0100 to 7680.0190 on a
- 4 first come, first served basis, based on the day an eligible and
- 5 complete application is received by the department. If eligible
- 6 and complete applications received on the same day cannot all be
- 7 funded due to lack of available funds, the department will first
- 8 process applications for previously unaudited buildings. If
- 9 funds are not available for all eligible applications for
- 10 previously unaudited buildings, the department will process
- ll grants so that each affected application receives an equal
- 12 percentage of the eligible grant amount. If funds are available
- 13 after processing all eligible applications for previously
- 14 unaudited buildings, the department will process eligible grant
- 15 applications for previously audited buildings. If funds are not
- 16 available for all eligible applications for previously audited
- 17 buildings, the department will process grants so that each
- 18 affected application receives an equal percentage of the
- 19 eligible grant amount. When all available funds have been
- 20 encumbered, the department will not process any further
- 21 applications, and affected applicants will be notified.
- Subp. 2. Limits. Grants will be issued by the department
- 23 for eligible applications up to the funding limits, based on
- 24 building size, as shown in the following table. The department
- 25 will reimburse grantees for 50 percent of the actual cost of a
- 26 cost-share maxi-audit or the approved grant amount, whichever is
- 27 less, when the requirements of part 7680.0180 have been met.

- 3 Subp. 3. Restrictions. Municipalities awarded cost-share
- 4 maxi-audit grants with money from alleged violations of federal
- 5 petroleum pricing regulations cannot use funding from this
- 6 program for the applicant's share of the cost of their
- 7 cost-share maxi-audit.
- 8 7680.0200 INCORPORATION BY REFERENCE.
- 9 The Cost-Share Maxi-Audit Manual (1987), written and
- 10 published by the Energy Division of the Department of Public
- 11 Service, is incorporated by reference. The manual is not
- 12 subject to frequent change and is available from the Department
- 13 of Public Service, 900 American Center Building, 150 East
- 14 Kellogg Boulevard, Saint Paul, MN 55101, and on the Minitex
- 15 interlibrary loan system from the Minnesota State Law Library,
