- 7 8250.0100 DEFINITION OF WHITE BALLOT.
- 8 The "white ballot" is the ballot used at general elections
- 9 and is the ballot on which are printed the names of the
- 10 candidates appearing on the presidential ballot and those
- 11 candidates nominated for the offices of United States senator,
- 12 United States representative, state senator, state
- 13 representative, governor and lieutenant governor, secretary of
- 14 state, state auditor, state treasurer, and attorney general.
- 15 8250.0600 OFFICES.
- 16 The offices must appear on the white ballot in the
- 17 following order and must be identified as follows in upper case
- 18 letters:
- 19 "PRESIDENT AND VICE-PRESIDENT"
- 20 "UNITED STATES SENATOR"
- 21 "UNITED STATES REPRESENTATIVE"
- 22 "STATE SENATOR"
- 23 "STATE REPRESENTATIVE"
- 24 "GOVERNOR AND LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR"
- 25 "SECRETARY OF STATE"
- 26 "STATE AUDITOR"
- 27 "STATE TREASURER"
- 28 "ATTORNEY GENERAL"
- "United States" may be abbreviated as "U.S." If an office
- 30 is not to be filled at a general election, the office must not
- 31 appear on the ballot. Directly underneath the titles of the
- 32 offices of United States representative and state senator and
- 33 representative must be printed in upper case letters or numbers
- 34 the district (for example: "SIXTH DISTRICT," "DISTRICT SIX," or
- 35 "DISTRICT 6") that the person elected will represent. A single

- l vote must be cast for president and vice-president and for
- 2 governor and lieutenant governor.

- 5 8250.1600 APPLICABILITY.
- 6 Parts 8250.1600 to 8250.1800 apply to electronic voting
- 7 systems, as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 206.56,
- 8 subdivision 8. To the extent possible, parts 8250.0100 to
- 9 8250.1500 apply to the use of electronic voting systems, unless
- 10 otherwise provided.
- 11 8250.1700 FORMAT OF BALLOT PAGES FOR PUNCH CARD SYSTEMS.
- 12 Subpart 1. Form. Punch card ballot pages must be printed
- 13 in the form illustrated in part 8250.9910.
- 14 Subp. 2. Order of office groups. For purposes of
- 15 organization, the ballot pages must be divided into separate
- 16 sections and headed by the following titles:
- 17 "FEDERAL OFFICES"
- 18 "STATE OFFICES"
- 19 "CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS"
- 20 The titles must be printed in upper case and bold face in
- 21 as large as practicable but no smaller than 36-point type and
- 22 must be carried on each ballot page that contains an office for
- 23 a particular category.
- 24 Subp. 3. Office titles. The office titles must be printed
- 25 in upper case and bold face in as large as practicable but no
- 26 smaller than 14-point type. The first legislative office
- 27 appearing on the ballot must be printed at the top of the page,
- 28 under the title "STATE OFFICES."
- 29 The instruction "VOTE FOR ONE" or "VOTE FOR ONE TEAM" must
- 30 be printed in upper case and bold face in as large as
- 31 practicable but no smaller than 10-point type.
- 32 Subp. 4. Candidate and party names. The candidate names
- 33 must be printed in upper case and bold face in as large as
- 34 practicable but no smaller than 12-point type. The party name
- 35 must be printed under the candidate name in as large as

- 1 practicable but no smaller than 8-point type.
- 2 Subp. 5. Ballot position numbers. The appropriate ballot
- 3 position number must be printed on the same line as the
- 4 candidate's name in as large as practicable but no smaller than
- 5 14-point type.
- 6 Subp. 6. Precinct identifiers. The name of the
- 7 municipality and the ward and precinct number, if any, for which
- 8 the ballot page has been prepared must be printed on the bottom
- 9 of each page on which candidate names appear. The date of the
- 10 election must be printed next to the precinct identifier. In
- 11 addition, each ballot page for a precinct must be sequentially
- 12 numbered. The page number must be printed in bold face in as
- 13 large as practicable but no smaller than 10-point type.
- 14 Subp. 7. Questions. The subject of a proposed question
- 15 must be printed in upper case and bold face in as large as
- 16 practicable but no smaller than 14-point type. The question
- 17 must be printed in bold face in as large as practicable but no
- 18 smaller than 12-point type. The words "YES" and "NO" must be
- 19 printed to the left of the appropriate ballot position number in
- 20 upper case and bold face in as large as practicable but no
- 21 smaller than 14-point type.
- 22 Subp. 8. Party preference indicator. In partisan primary
- 23 elections, the ballot booklet must include a place to allow the
- 24 voter to indicate the primary election in which the voter
- 25 intends to vote. This party preference indicator must appear on
- 26 the first ballot page preceding the pages containing the
- 27 partisan offices. The page containing the party preference
- 28 indicators must be printed in the form illustrated in part
- 29 8250.9920.
- 30 Subp. 9. Designation of party colors. The secretary of
- 31 state shall notify the county auditor of each county of any
- 32 colors used to designate a major political party at a state
- 33 election. Notification must be made at the same time that the
- 34 secretary of state certifies the names of the candidates to be
- 35 nominated at the state primary election.
- 36 Subp. 10. Color of ballot pages. The names of candidates

- 1 to be nominated for each major political party at a partisan
- 2 primary election must be printed on pages of the color required
- 3 by statute for that party. No page may contain the candidates
- 4 of more than one major political party. All pages containing
- 5 nonpartisan candidates or questions and the page containing the
- 6 party preference indicator must be white.
- 7 8250.1800 FORMAT OF BALLOT CARDS FOR OPTICAL SCAN SYSTEMS.
- 8 Subpart 1. Type sizes. The type sizes in items A to D
- 9 must be used in the printing of ballot cards.
- 10 A. The titles "FEDERAL OFFICES," "STATE OFFICES," and
- 11 "CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS" must be printed in upper case and
- 12 bold face in as large as practicable but no smaller than
- 13 14-point type.
- B. The office titles must be printed in upper case
- 15 and bold face in as large as practicable but no smaller than
- 16 10-point type. Immediately under each office title, the
- 17 instruction "VOTE FOR ONE" or "VOTE FOR ONE TEAM" must be
- 18 printed in upper case and bold face in as large as practicable
- 19 but no smaller than 8-point type.
- 20 C. The candidate names must be printed in upper case
- 21 in as large as practicable but no smaller than 10-point type.
- 22 The party name must be printed under the candidate name in as
- 23 large as practicable but no smaller than 8-point type.
- D. The subject of a proposed question must be printed
- 25 in upper case and bold face in as large as practicable but no
- 26 smaller than 10-point type. The question must be printed in
- 27 bold face in as large as practicable but no smaller than 8-point
- 28 type. The words "YES" and "NO" must be printed to the left of
- 29 the vote targets in upper case and bold face in as large as
- 30 practicable but no smaller than 10-point type.
- 31 Subp. 2. Vote targets. The target used to indicate to the
- 32 voters where to mark their votes may be either an arrow pointing
- 33 toward the candidate name or a horizontal oval next to the
- 34 candidate name. The target may be highlighted or outlined in a
- 35 color that does not affect the ability of the ballot counter to

- 1 read the ballot.
- Subp. 3. Extraneous marks. No election official may place
- 3 marks on the ballot other than those provided in Minnesota
- 4 Statutes, section 204C.09, subdivision 1.
