7 8700.5200 TEACHERS OF AMERICAN INDIAN LANGUAGE AND AMERICAN
8 INDIAN HISTORY AND CULTURE.

9 Subpart 1. and 2. [Unchanged.]

10 Subp. 3. **License application.** An application for a
11 license authorized by this part may be submitted by persons on
12 their own behalf or may be submitted by the superintendent or
13 other authorized official of a school district, participating
14 school as defined in Minnesota Statutes, section 126.47,
15 subdivision 4, or an American Indian school, on behalf of a
16 person who has demonstrated competence in an American Indian
17 language and/or knowledge and understanding of an American
18 Indian history and culture. The application shall specify the
19 language, and/or the history and culture, and grade levels to be
20 taught by the applicant and shall also include the following:

24 Subp. 7. **Continuing licensure.** A continuing license shall
25 be issued and renewed according to rules of the Board of
26 Teaching governing continuing education relicensure.
