7 4670.2300 CERTIFICATION METHODS.

Subpart 1. Competitive register. After receiving a 8 requisition, the supervisor shall certify the names of available 9 eligibles. If one position is involved, the supervisor shall 10 certify the 15 highest available names together with any 11 additional names of persons having an examination rating within 12 three points of the person on the certification with the highest 13 examination rating, and any additional names of persons having 14 15 the same examination score as that of the 15th person certified, from the open competitive register established for the class of 16 positions. Names of available eligibles from the appropriate 17 reemployment register, if one exists, shall also be certified as 18 19 additional names.

20 Subp. 2. Promotional register. The supervisor may also certify the seven highest available names together with any 21 22 additional names of persons having an examination rating within three points of the person on the certification with the highest 23 examination rating, and any additional names of persons having 24 25 the same examination score as that of the seventh name certified, from the appropriate promotional register if such 26 27 register exists and is requested. Names of available eligibles 28 from the appropriate reemployment register, if one exists, shall also be certified as additional names. 29

30 Subp. 3. Multiple vacancies. If more than one vacancy 31 exists, the supervisor shall certify at least as many names from 32 the register as there are vacancies to be filled, together with 33 any additional names of persons having an examination rating 34 within three points of the person on the certification with the 35 highest examination rating, and any additional names of persons

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having the same examination score as that of the 15th person
certified on a competitive certification or as that of the
seventh person certified on a promotional certification.
Supplementary certifications will be issued only in instances in
which it is found that there are less than 15 available
candidates on the competitive certification or seven available
candidates on the promotional certification.

8 Subp. 4. Selection for appointment. The appointing 9 authority may select for appointment anyone among the certified 10 candidates who is eligible for appointment.

Subp. 5. Inadequate registers. When the number of names 11 12 available for filling any vacancy by original appointment, promotion, or reinstatement is fewer than 15 on a competitive 13 certification or seven on a promotional certification, and there 14 are fewer than three different names on all registers combined, 15 the appointing authority may decline certification for that 16 17 vacancy and may request certification from a register, or registers, that the supervisor deems appropriate. 18

Subp. 6. Provisional appointments. If there is no register that the supervisor deems appropriate, then the vacancy may be filled provisionally as provided for in part 4670.2510, subpart 1.

Subp. 7. Expanded certification. When the supervisor 23 determines that a disparity exists between an agency's work 24 force and its approved affirmative action plan, the supervisor 25 shall ensure to the extent possible that available eligibles who 26 are members of the protected group as defined in Minnesota 27 Statutes, section 43A.02, subdivision 33, for which the 28 29 disparity exists are certified for appointment. When fewer than three protected group eligibles for which a disparity exists 30 would be certified under subparts 1 and 2, the supervisor shall 31 certify additional protected group eligibles for which a 32 disparity exists to bring the number of eligibles certified to a 33 total of three names from each protected group. Eligibles to be 34 certified shall be determined by examination score. 35

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
