7 4625.2300 INITIAL AND RENEWAL LICENSE FEES, LICENSE EXPIRATION
8 DATES.

9 Subpart 1. Fee schedule. License applications for lodging
10 establishments as defined in part 4625.0100 shall be accompanied
11 by a fee of \$67 plus \$2.70 per room, up to a maximum total fee
12 of \$337.50.

13 Subp. 2. and 3. [Unchanged.]

14 Subp. 4. Penalty fee. A penalty fee of \$20 shall be added
15 to the amount of the license fee if the application has not
16 reached the office of the commissioner of health before January
17 31, or in the case of a new business, 30 days after opening the
18 business.

19 Subp. 5. [Unchanged.]

20 4625.5000 INITIAL AND RENEWAL LICENSE FEES, LICENSE EXPIRATION
21 DATES.

22 Subpart 1. Fee schedule. Initial and renewal license
23 applications for food and beverage establishments as defined in
24 part 4625.2400 shall be accompanied by the applicable fee as
25 determined from the schedule below. The average number of
26 employees shall be computed in accordance with Minnesota
27 Statutes, section 157.03.

28 A. one to four employees, \$70.35;

29 B. five to 18, \$120.60;

30 C. 19 to 28, \$180.90;

31 D. 29 to 35, \$251.25;

32 E. 36 and over, \$301.50; and

33 F. limited food or beverage establishments that sell
34 only prepackaged foods that receive heat treatment and are
35 served in the package, mobile units, or itinerant and special

1 event stands serving food or beverages for 14 days or less in
2 any single location, \$50.25.

3 Subp. 2. and 3. [Unchanged.]

4 Subp. 4. Penalty fee. A penalty fee of \$20 shall be added
5 to the amount of the license fee if the license renewal
6 application has not reached the commissioner of health before
7 January 31 of the year for which the license is to be issued, or
8 in the case of a new business, 30 days after the opening the
9 business.
