7 5220.1500 PROCEDURE FOR QUALIFYING AS REHABILITATION CONSULTANT.

8 Subpart 1. **Application.** An individual desiring to receive  
9 approval and registration as a qualified rehabilitation  
10 consultant shall submit to the commissioner, a complete  
11 application consisting of the following:

12 A. to F. [Unchanged.]

13 G. the annual registration fee of \$100 for each  
14 qualified rehabilitation consultant or qualified rehabilitation  
15 consultant intern.

16 The commissioner shall issue a notice of acceptance or  
17 rejection to the applicant within 60 days of receipt of the  
18 completed application. Acceptance will be provisional until the  
19 completion of an introductory training session.

29 5220.1700 PROCEDURE FOR APPROVAL AS REGISTERED REHABILITATION  
30 VENDOR.

31 Subpart 1. **Application.** A private or public entity  
32 desiring to be approved as a registered rehabilitation vendor  
33 shall submit to the commissioner a complete application  
34 consisting of all of the following:

2           D. The annual registration fee of \$200 for each
