- 6 5230.0040 DEFINITIONS.
- 7 Subpart 1. to 3. [Unchanged.]
- 8 Subp. 4. Pipefitter trainee. A "pipefitter trainee" is
- 9 any person other than a contracting or journeyman steamfitter,
- 10 whose principal occupation is learning and assisting in the
- 11 installation of high pressure steam piping and appurtenances
- 12 under the direct supervision of a licensed steamfitter.
- 13 5230.0050 LICENSING AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT.
- No person, firm, corporation, or association shall engage
- 15 in the business or work at the occupation of high pressure steam
- 16 piping in the state of Minnesota without first obtaining a
- 17 license and being registered as a contracting or journeyman
- 18 steamfitter, as the case may be, and no licensed contractor
- 19 shall employ a journeyman steamfitter, to install high pressure
- 20 steam piping unless such journeyman is a licensed steamfitter;
- 21 and no person shall work as a pipefitter trainee for more than
- 22 30 days without being registered as such, nor longer than four
- 23 years without making application for examination and license as
- 24 a steamfitter.
- 25 Licenses shall be granted as contracting or journeyman
- 26 steamfitters upon proof of qualifications therefor as
- 27 hereinafter provided, and no pipefitter trainee shall be
- 28 registered as such who is not at least 16 years of age.
- 29 An applicant for a contractor's license to do business in
- 30 the name of a firm or partnership shall be a bona fide member or
- 31 employee of such firm or partnership. An applicant for a
- 32 contractor's license to do business in the name of a corporation
- 33 shall be a regular employee or member in such corporation.
- 34 5230.0080 JOURNEYMAN STEAMFITTER QUALIFICATIONS.

Approved by Revisor

- 1 Applicants for license shall:
- A. be at least 20 years of age;
- B. possess sufficient education to read and
- 4 comprehend blueprints and specifications for the installation of
- 5 high pressure steam piping;
- 6 C. be of good moral character;
- 7 D. have been a registered pipefitter trainee or
- 8 journeyman steamfitter for at least four years;
- 9 E. pay an examination fee; and
- F. pass the required examination by at least 70
- 11 percent.
- 12 5230.0110 REGISTRATION OF TRAINEES.
- 13 Subpart 1. and 2. [See Repealer.]
- 14 Subp. 2a. Annual registration, supervision. All
- 15 contracting pipefitters shall, within ten days of the employment
- 16 of a pipefitter trainee, inform the department of the employment
- 17 of the pipefitter trainee, giving the name, address, age, and
- 18 date of employment of the pipefitter trainee.
- 19 All persons learning the trade of pipefitting shall
- 20 register with the department on an annual basis until the four
- 21 years of training are documented. The registration shall be
- 22 made at the time of initial registration with the department and
- 23 annually after that on the anniversary of the initial
- 24 registration. Upon completion and verification of four years of
- 25 employment and training by a licensed contracting pipefitter,
- 26 the pipefitter trainee shall make application for examination
- 27 and license as a journeyman.
- 28 All persons learning the trade of pipefitting shall be
- 29 under the direct supervision of a contracting or journeyman
- 30 pipefitter,-and-when-working-on-high-pressure-piping-projects,
- 31 shall-be-limited-to-working-on-permitted-projects-under-the
- 32 provisions-of-Minnesota-Statutes,-section-326-47,-subdivision
- 33 1. The minimum ratio of pipefitter trainees to licensed
- 34 pipefitters on the jobsite shall be:
- 35 A. one pipefitter trainee for the first licensed

- l pipefitter; and
- B. one pipefitter trainee for every three licensed
- 3 pipefitters after that; provided, that at least one journeyman
- 4 or contracting pipefitter must be on the jobsite at all times
- 5 when work is in progress.
- 6 Upon-completion-and-verification-of-four-years-of
- 7 employment-and-training-by-a-licensed-contracting-pipefitter,
- 8 the-pipefitter-trainee-may-make-application-for-examination-and
- 9 license-as-a-journeyman.
- Subp. 3. Changes in employment or address. All registered
- 11 pipefitter trainees shall inform the department of changes of
- 12 employment and their address.
- 13 5230.0130 DUTIES OF LICENSED CONTRACTING STEAMFITTERS.
- A contracting steamfitter employing a journeyman
- 15 steamfitter or a pipefitter trainee shall comply with all the
- 16 laws, rules, and minimum standards of the state of Minnesota,
- 17 paying promptly for labor and material furnished an owner, and
- 18 reporting income tax and conforming to the laws governing the
- 19 relationship of master and servant, including the carrying or
- 20 workmen's compensation insurance, paying the Social Security
- 21 tax, paying wages when due, furnishing written contracts of
- 22 employment, and employing licensed steamfitters on high pressure
- 23 pipe work.

- 25 REVISOR'S INSTRUCTION. In the next edition of Minnesota
- 26 Rules, the Revisor of Statutes shall substitute the term
- 27 "pipefitter" wherever the term "steamfitter" appears in chapter
- 28 5230, including headnotes and delete the word "steam" wherever
- 29 it appears in chapter 5230, including headnotes, except that the
- 30 word "steam" shall not be deleted from part 5230.0040, subpart 2.

- 32 REPEALER. Minnesota Rules, part 5230.0110, subparts 1 and
- 33 2, are repealed.

35 APPLICATION. Part 5230.0110 applies to all high pressure

- 1 piping projects after December-31,-1989 January 31, 1990, to
- 2 high pressure piping pipefitter trainees registered
- 3 after December-31,-1989 January 31, 1990, and to all high
- 4 pressure piping pipefitter apprentices registered with the
- 5 department before January February 1, 1990.
