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6 Rules as Adopted

7 4690.5000 LAPSED CERTIFICATES.

8 An applicant may renew a lapsed certificate as follows:

9 A. within 12 months of the certificate expiration
10 date, complete an approved emergency care refresher course and
11 pass the written and practical examinations approved by the
12 commissioner;

13 B. if more than 12 months have passed since the
14 certificate expiration date, complete an approved emergency care
15 course and pass the written and practical examinations approved
16 by the commissioner; or

17 C. petition the commissioner for reinstatement as a
18 state-certified emergency medical technician upon successful
19 completion of an emergency care refresher course approved by the
20 commissioner. The applicant must provide evidence of
21 registration with the National Registry of Emergency Medical
22 Technicians or certification as a Minnesota emergency medical
23 services technician. The registration or certification must
24 have an expiration date before January 1, 1989. Proper evidence
25 may consist of the following:

26 (1) a copy of an emergency medical
27 technician-ambulance or nonambulance registration issued by the
28 National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians;

29 (2) a copy of a Minnesota emergency medical care
30 certificate issued by the commissioner under part 4690.4600; or

31 (3) a statement from a training institution with
32 an approved emergency care refresher course, that documents the
33 applicant's past status as an emergency medical technician under
34 subitems (1) and (2). This statement must be accompanied by
35 written verification from the medical advisor or medical

1 director and the chief administrative representative of an
2 ambulance service licensed by the commissioner to operate within
3 Minnesota.

4 This item expires August 1, 1994. Only applicants enrolled
5 in an approved emergency care refresher course on or after April
6 27, 1989, may apply for reinstatement as a state certified
7 emergency medical technician under this item.
