- 8 Subp. 5. Separation of breeding swine. "Separation of
- 9 breeding swine" means the maintenance of the swine at least six
- 10 feet from other swine or divided by solid partitions that will
- 11 prevent nose-to-nose contact with other swine.
- 12 1700.2800 CONTENTS OF CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION.
- 13 Certificates of veterinary inspection for feeder swine must
- 14 list identification numbers, the herd of origin, the
- 15 destination, and one of the following statements: "these feeder
- 16 swine originate from a pseudorabies monitored herd," "these
- 17 feeder swine originate from a pseudorabies qualified herd,"
- 18 "these feeder swine have all been tested for pseudorabies within
- 19 30 days before importation and found negative," or "these feeder
- 20 swine originate from an officially designated Stage III, IV, or
- 21 V pseudorabies area," as defined in part 1705.2400, subpart 5a,
- 22 and the State-Federal Program Standards for Pseudorabies
- 23 Eradication.
- 24 Certificates of veterinary inspection for breeding swine
- 25 must show the individual identification number of each animal.
- 26 Acceptable individual identification must be either eartag,
- 27 tattoo, registration number, or approved ear notch system, the
- 28 date of test, if tested, the validated and qualified herd number
- 29 and date of last test, if not tested within 30 days before
- 30 importation.
- 31 Certificates of veterinary inspection for feral swine must
- 32 list individual eartag numbers and show that the swine were for

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- 33 pseudorabies and found negative within 30 days before
- 34 importation.
- One copy of the certificate of veterinary inspection

- 3 1700.2850 FEEDER SWINE.
- 4 Feeder swine must originate from pseudorables monitored
- 5 herds, qualified pseudorabies negative herds, or an officially
- 6 designated Stage III, IV, or V pseudorabies area, or must be
- 7 tested negative within 30 days, and must not be transported or
- 8 confined with swine of unknown status. Feral swine may not be
- 9 imported into Minnesota without a negative pseudorabies test
- 10 within the previous 30 days.
- 11 1700.2900 BREEDING SWINE.
- Breeding swine must be:
- 13 A. negative to the brucellosis buffered antigen test
- 14 conducted at a state or federal laboratory within 30 days prior
- 15 to importation, or originate from a validated brucellosis free
- 16 swine herd, or originate directly from a nonquarantined herd in
- 17 a validated brucellosis free state;
- B. negative to an official test for pseudorabies
- 19 within 30 days prior to importation or originate from a
- 20 qualified pseudorabies negative herd; and
- 21 C. isolated separated from all other swine until
- 22 tested negative not less than 30 nor more than 60 days following
- 23 importation according to the following sample size:
- 24 (1) if there are ten or less breeding swine, all
- 25 must be tested;
- 26 (2) if there are 11 to 35 breeding swine, ten
- 27 must be tested; and
- 28 (3) if there are 36 or more breeding swine, 30
- 29 percent or 30 head, whichever is less, must be tested.
- This item does not apply to breeding stock sales centers in
- 31 Minnesota as provided in parts 1705.2400, subpart 15, and
- 32 1705.2480, subpart 9.
- 33 Breeding swine must not be transported or confined with
- 34 swine of unknown status.
