Household reports. Each assistance unit with a 9 member who has earned income or a recent work history, and each 10 assistance unit that has income allocated to it from a 11 financially responsible person living with that unit who has 12 earned income or a recent work history, shall complete a monthly 13 household report form. "Recent work history" means the 14 individual received earned income in any one of the three 15 calendar months preceding the current payment month. Monthly 16 reports must also be completed by each assistance unit in a 17 category that has a greater proportion of the state's total 18 program errors than that category's proportion of the state's 19 20 total program caseload, as identified through the quality control review process, and when monthly reporting is expected 21 to reduce the error rate for that category. To be complete, a 22 household report form must be signed and dated by a caretaker no 23 earlier than the last day of the reporting period; all questions 24 25 required to determine assistance payment eligibility must be answered, and documentation of earned income must be included. 26 A recipient shall submit the household report form in time for 27 the local agency to receive it by the eighth calendar day of the 28 month following the reporting period covered by the form. 29 When the eighth calendar day of the month falls on a weekend or 30 holiday, a recipient must submit the household report form in 31 32 time for the local agency to receive it by the first working day that follows the eighth calendar day. Delays in submitting the 33 34 completed household report form may delay an assistance payment in the month following the month in which the form is due. When 35

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1 the household report form is late without good cause, except as 2 qualified in subpart 6, item C, the recipient is subject to the 3 following penalty:

When a completed household report form is received by a local agency after the last day of the month following the month in which the form is due, and when the delayed household report form reports earned income, an assistance unit shall lose the earned income disregards under part 9500.2580 for the payment month corresponding to the last month covered by the household report form.
